NARRATIVE

On the above date and time and while assigned to patrol in Sector 1, I operating a Green Ford Explorer, Mass Reg observed 22WY37, and knew him to have a suspended license status. This officer stopped the motor vehicle on North Union Street at Patrick Street. I notified dispatch of my location and requested that another unit respond. Once I approached the vehicle, I requested that produce his stated that he didn't have it. I asked him if he actually had a license to which he replied "I think it might be suspended". There were two other passengers in the vehicle, both well known to this and Brendan Reilly. Officer C. Brown arrived department. on scene. Dispatch confirmed that silver is license was suspended. was removed from the vehicle and taken into custody, handcuffed (double-locked) searched and placed in the rear of cruiser 351 for transport to the station.

Tow was requested for the vehicle. The rear passenger, Brendan Reilly, was taken from the vehicle. I asked Reilly if he had any items on him that he shouldn't have to which he responded "I'm might have a small bud". At this point, I searched Reilly's pockets and found in his left front pocket, a small piece of tin foil wrapped around 3 white pills bearing the imprint R35. I then asked Reilly what the pills were and he stated Klonapin. Reilly informed me that he takes the medication for psychiatric reasons however, he could not produce a pill bottle or a prescription for the pills and was subsequently taken into custody, handcuffed (doublelocked) and placed in a seated position on the ground in front of cruiser 351.

I then requested that the front passenger, to the rear of the vehicle, Sgt. Pedrini was standing at the open door of the passenger seat and observed in plain veiw a plastic baggie sticking out from under the seat which was just removed from. Sgt. Pedrini then removed the baggie and stated that it contained 4 individually wrapped baggies which were filled with a green leafy substance believed to be marijuana. was taken into custody, handcuffed(double locked), and also placed on the ground in front of cruiser 351. Officer C. Brown responded to the station to get the wagon, while I complete inventory of the vehicle and Sgt. Pedrini stood watch over the prisoners. I completed this Department's Motor Vehicle Inventory Form.

and Reilly were placed in the wagon and tranported by Officer C. Brown while I transported in 351. Sgt. Pedrini stood by with the vehicle and awaited the arrival of Palmer's. Once at the station all 3 parties were booked, given all applicable rights, photographed and fingerprinted and placed in male cells. was charged with 90/24 Operating after Suspension and issued Citation # M3277312. Reilly was charged with Possession of Class C (Klonapin). was charged with 94C/34 Possession of Class D and 94C/32 Possession of Class D with Intent to distribute.

In the presence of Sgt. Pedrini, I weighed the plastic baggie containing the substance believed to be marijuana and it weighed in at .4 oz including the packaging. The pills and the marijuana were placed in to evidence bags and placed in evidence locker # 3. The key was placed in the drop box. All documents attached hereto.
