NARRATIVE

On 8/11/06 at approximately 0040 hours this officer, Michael Flynn, was on patrol parked in the area of 860 Mass Ave when I was approached by two males traveling in a black Nissan Pathfinder bearing MA reg 12JT43. The two men were later identified as [REDACTED] operator, and the passenger being Brendan Reilly. [REDACTED] is Brendan's father. Brendan is

known to the Arlington Police from previous incidents the latest occurring on 8/6/06.

After notifying dispatch I spoke with [REDACTED] Officers B Kiernan and J Kiernan responded to my location. [REDACTED] informed me that he had an argument with his son Brendan and that he wanted Brendan out of the vehicle. [REDACTED] and Brendan were separated and I spoke with [REDACTED] further. [REDACTED] stated that he and Brendan were arguing over Brendan's arrest on 8/6/06 which was publicized in the Arlington Advocate. [REDACTED] also stated that at no time during the argument did he and Brendan become physical with each other.

I then spoke with Brendan who stated his father was angry about Brendan being arrested and that it was noted in the Advocate. Brendan also stated that there was no physical contact between he and [REDACTED]

I then spoke with [REDACTED] again and he informed me Brendan would be allowed to stay in the vehicle.

[REDACTED] and Brendan were each issued right's of victims of domestic violence forms.

Warrant checks and BOPs were completed on [REDACTED] and Brendan with negative results.
