On 4-27-07 at 14:46 hours, Officer Reid, Officer Busa and I (Officer Vitale) responded to 17 Reeves Road on a report of a domestic disturbance. Upon arrival I observed Officer Reid speaking with a male in the driveway of the residence. The male was later identified as Brendan Reilly.

Officer Busa went inside and spoke with the caller, [REDACTED] Reilly, regarding the incident. Officer Reid and I spoke with Brendan Reilly outside of the home. B. Reilly related that he and his father had an argument this afternoon. B. Reilly related that the argument stemmed from his father "making fun" of his disability. B. Reilly would not elaborate on his disability, however, he related that his father would constantly tease him about his condition. B. Reilly related that the argument escalated and that he got angry and slammed a chair against the floor. B. Reilly related that he picked the chair up a short distance and slammed it back onto the floor. B. Reilly related that he did this out of frustration and that he would not assault his father out of respect.

Officer Busa returned and related that K. Reilly related a very similar account of the events, including, the chair being slammed on the floor. Officer Busa related that K. Reilly had been advised of his rights under chapter 209A of the Massachusetts General Laws. Officer Busa related that K. Reilly related that he did not wish to seek an emergency restraining order and would go to Concord District Court on Monday and apply for an order. Officer Busa related that K. Reilly's request was that his son leave the residence for the weekend. K. Reilly informed Officer Busa that his son suffers from a form of psychosis. Officer Busa had to leave the area to respond to another call for service.

Officer Reid and I accompanied B. Reilly into the residence where he could retrieve some personal belongings. While inside I spoke with K. Reilly. K. Reilly related that he only wished that his son would leave the home for the weekend and that he would address the situation on Monday. B. Reilly gathered some belongings and I gave him a courtesy transport to the M.B.T.A. bus stop. B. Reilly related that he would be going to a friends home in Arlington. B. Reilly also asked for a telephone number and address for a homeless shelter in the Arlington area. With the assistance of Emergency Communications I supplied B. Reilly with the name and address of a homeless shelter in Cambridge, referred to as 240 Albany Street.
