**Arrest Narrative:**

**By Trooper John B Skabeikis #3353**

1. On Tuesday July 17, 2007 at approximately 1:45pm while on patrol RT93N in Andover I observed a vehicle located in the emergency pull off area. I approached the vehicle and observed it to be unoccupied. At this time I observed two pedestrians walking in the breakdown lane across the highway RT93 southbound. At this point I proceeded to turn around at exit 45 and head to the pedestrians walking 93 southbound.

2. At this time I activated my rear cruiser lights and stopped behind the two male pedestrians. The first male later identified as [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]-64) stated that there they were driving the vehicle that was broken down on the northbound side. He stated the he thinks the vehicle was overheating. He also stated he did not own the vehicle and was just borrowing it from a friend. At this point I requested identification for both parties. The second male later identified as REILLY, BRENDAN (DOB 6-18-86) stated he did not have any identification. Both [REDACTED] and REILLY stated that they did not have a driver's license. When asked who was driving the vehicle both [REDACTED] and REILLY looked at each other and would not answer.

3. At this point I noticed REILLY becoming more agitated and nervous. He kept putting his hands in his pockets after repeatedly being told not to. For my safety I separated the parties having [REDACTED] take a seat on the guardrail in front of my cruiser. I then had REILLY step to the rear of my cruiser. While at the rear of my cruiser REILLY again kept putting his hands in his pockets after repeatedly being told not to. At this time I asked if I could search his pockets for my safety and he consented. Prior to searching his pockets REILLY stated he had a bag of marijuana in one pocket. While conducting a pat frisk I discovered 1 plastic bag containing green leafy substance believed to be marijuana, 1 rolled cigarette filled with same and 1 small roach filled with same. Also in his pockets I discovered 8 white pills that REILLY stated were "KLONAPIN". REILLY then stated he had a prescription for the pills but did not have the bottle or prescription with him. He was then placed in cuffs and seated in the rear of my cruiser. At this time TPR Bambrick arrived on scene to assist.

4. I then proceeded to the front of my cruiser and had further conversation with [REDACTED]. After further conversation with [REDACTED] he stated that he had a bag of marijuana on him. He then proceeded to pull a plastic bag from the back inside of his shorts. [REDACTED] stated when he saw my cruiser pull up behind him he stuffed the bag into his rectum. The plastic bag contained a green leafy substance believed to be marijuana. [REDACTED] was then placed in cuffs and seated in my cruiser. While in the rear of my cruiser I issued both parties their Miranda Rights. Both [REDACTED] and REILLY were then transported to SP-Andover for booking

5. At SP-Andover, [REDACTED] and REILLY were booked to include being photographed and property inventory. They were also readvised of their Miranda Rights, they both stated they understood their rights. REILLY again stated he had a prescription for the pills. At this time I had conversation with the vehicle owner who stated he had let [REDACTED] borrow the car on this day. I advised him the vehicle was towed to Coady's Tow.
