NARRATIVE

On 09/14/07 at 1751 hrs. while assigned to Car # 354 (Sec #4) I was dispatched to Johnnies Foodmaster located at 808 Mass. Ave. Arl.

regarding an incident of shoplifting with the suspect leaving the store. The suspect was described as a white male wearing white shorts and a white shirt with the name Wade on the back. While en route to Johnnies Foodmaster I observed a subject fitting the description walking westerly on Mass. Ave. in the area of 995 Mass. Ave. Arl. I approached the subj. identified as Brendan Riley and asked him where he was coming from and he responded, "Stop & Shop". I asked him if he had just been at Johnnies Foodmaster and he stated, "no". The subj. (Riley) was carrying an open bag of beef jerky of which he stated that he had purchased at the Stop & Shop. A warrant check was initiated on Brendan Riley with negative results.

Off. Paradis spoke with the RP manager of Johnnies Foodmaster and he related to him that he observed the subj. in the store and order a sandwich at the Deli Dept. The RP stated that the subj. was walking down the aisles and observed him pick up a bottle of BBQ sauce and place both items under his shirt and walk out of the store. Off. Paradis observed the store video and observed the subj. in question (Riley) who is also known to Off. Paradis place the items under his shirt and walk out the store. It appears as the subj. (Riley) walked out the store, the items under his shirt fell to the ground. The RP doesn't wish to pursue this matter criminally but would like the subj. (Riley) advised not to come back in the store and that he would be trespassing. This officer advised the subj. (Riley) that he was no longer welcomed in Johnnies Foodmaster and that if he should return it would be construed as a trespass.
