Reilly came into the station to speak with an officer. At this time Mr. Reilly related the

His 23 year old son, Brendan Reilly is deemed by the State as disabled. Brendan collects social security for this disability. Previously Brendan was residing at home and the domestic outbursts, fights, and altercations that were arising led to Mr. Reilly being arrested, see incident #2008-2001. Since that time the family has paid significant financial debts to keep Brendan in an appropriate facility to deal with his conditions. Mr. Reilly related that due to the costs, and some other issues, Brendan has come home to live with them recently. At this time Brendan continues to abuse alcohol, drugs and be abusive towards he, Mr. Reilly, and his wife. Brendan takes Mr. Reilly's car without permission and does not have a license amongst other issues. Mr. Reilly was not willing to explain Brendan's full disability to me. He related he does not wish to release private medical information. I explained to Mr. Reilly that there are options available with the DMH, DPPC, Maclean's facility and other State agency's but I did not know what direction to lead him in if he can not explain further.

I referred Mr. Reilly to a section 35, for Drug and alcohol abuse within the court. I also referred him to a refrain from abuse order, different from the restraining order. I asked Mr. Reilly if he felt he needed an emergency restraining order presently and he felt that he "could make it until Tuesday". I assisted Mr. Reilly in filing a request for needed reports within the department as well as referred him to other town wide services. Mr. Reilly did not want further assistance, and felt very strongly that he did not want this to be public information or broadcasted. Mr. Reilly was distraught and upset over his son being so abusive and he not knowing how to handle the situation.

A BOP was conducted on Brendan and he has 10 previous arraingments for cont substance, poss of alcohol, breaking and entering, etc. See attached BOP. Brendan has no current open charges.
