NARRATIVE

On Tuesday 3-9-10, at approximately 1405 hours, this Officer while assigned to Sector 3 was dispatched to the area of 475 Mass Ave for assistance with a white male who passed out, but was breathing. Upon arrival, this Officer observed a party, later identified as Brendan Riley, passed out on the bench in front of 475 Mass Ave. Also on scene were 2 parties this Officer knows quite well.

Both said that they had met Riley in the center about an hour before he passed out, and claimed that he was on medication. Neither provided any other information. Riley had come to, but could not be understood as he talked only in mumbles.

With the arrival of Arlington Fire and Armstrong, they believe Riley had stated that he had taken over 30 Xanax pills and lived somewhere in Bedford. This Officer searched Riley and could not find identification, nor any prescription medications. This Officer did not detect any signs of alcohol nor other drug use. Riley was then transported to Mt. Auburn Hospital.
