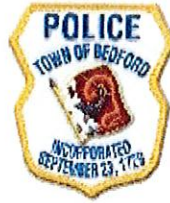

On 12-18-11 at approx. 16:04hrs I, Car5 Officer French was asked to speak to parties in the lobby requesting advice for a domestic situation.

Upon my arrival I met with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Reilly. Mr. and Mrs. Reilly related that they are having problems with their 25 year old son, Brendan. Brendan has been diagnosed with mental illness and is under a physicians care. (The Bedford Police have been to the home on several occasions.) The Reilly's related that Brendan is now abusing drugs, primarily marijuana. They related that he is becoming a "Nightmare" at home with his controlling and demanding ways.

I asked Mr. and Mrs. Reilly what had brought them to the Police today. They related that Brendan had taken one of the family cars without permission, the vehicles are registered to Mr. Reilly, and they believe he is on a "Drug run". They related that he has done this in the past and has returned home with the vehicle. Mr. and Mrs. Reilly related that they need advice as what to do next. I asked if they had been speaking with Brendan's doctor. They related that they have, but because of Brendan's age, they are not getting a lot of information or assistance. I then advised Mr. and Mrs. Reilly that they should consider a Section 35. I explained that they would need to go to the Concord District Court and speak to the Clerk's Office and tell their story. They agreed to think about it.

At this time I advised Sgt Towle of the incident. Sgt Towle advised I print out the Section 35 information and pass it along. I handed the information to the Reilly's. Mr. and Mrs. Reilly decided that they would go home and see if Brendan had returned with their vehicle and would not seek any action until then. They related that they would discuss the Section 35 together and go from there. I advised them to contact the Police if Brendan does not return home with the vehicle.

As of this report the Reilly's have not called the Station. No further Police action taken.
