NARRATIVE

On 08/10/2012 at approximately 1400 hours I, Inspector Gallagher while patrolling the area of Arlington center observed several parties well known to Arlington Police hanging outside of Starbucks Coffee. Arlington Police have received numerous complaints in the past of drug activity and kids loitering in this area. Two of the parties [REDACTED] ([REDACTED] 1992) and Brendan Reilly (06/18/1986) , met with two unknown parties , later identified as [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] , outside the Starbucks with [REDACTED] talking on his cell phone. At this time [REDACTED] hung up his phone , put his finger on the side of his nose and made a gesture mimicking blowing a line of cocaine. He then hugged Reilly and slapped him a high five. At this time Inspector Foley arrived on scene and assisted in the surveillance on these individuals.

After a short time period [REDACTED] met an unknown black individual wearing a white tank top on a skate board on Medford Street. While sitting in my vehicle I observed [REDACTED] hand something to the unknown black male and the black male hand something back to [REDACTED] , at which time [REDACTED] and the other individuals walked down Medford Street. Through my training and experience I believe I witnessed a street level , hand to hand drug transaction.

At this time Inspector Foley and myself followed the individuals through the Arlington Catholic Parking lot and enter a parked motor vehicle. At this time Inspector Foley parked his unmarked police vehicle at the rear of the parked motor vehicle and I exited my vehicle, announced my office and displayed my department issued police badge. As I approached the driver's side of the motor vehicle I observed [REDACTED] sitting in the back seat , make eye contact with me and immediately move his hands down towards his feet. I also observed Reilly in the back seat begin to make furtive movements. Due to the fact [REDACTED] has made threats to kill and shoot Officer Hogan' s family , [REDACTED] and all parties in the vehicle were ordered to show their hands and removed from the vehicle. At this time Officer Conroy and Inspector Bassett arrived on scene.

In the rear of the vehicle was [REDACTED] Brendan Reilly, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. I spoke with [REDACTED], who had visible Heroin track marks on both of his arms. [REDACTED] stated, he was with his girlfriend [REDACTED] and had just met these individuals. He stated, he has a Heroin problem and just shot up yesterday. He stated, the two other guys, [REDACTED] and Reilly asked if he knew where to get Suboxin, he said yes and would bring him to Cambridge. At this time I spoke to [REDACTED] who stated, she was with her boyfriend [REDACTED] and these guys asked if he could get them some Suboxin. [REDACTED] was carrying a bag of clothes and gave me permission to search it. Inside the bag was a brown paper bag with 12 hypodermic needles. At this time [REDACTED] stated, they were his needles. The needles were taken from the scene and destroyed at the station. Officer Siempos arrived on scene.

The owner of the vehicle [REDACTED] and his girlfriend [REDACTED] were also removed from the vehicle for Officer safety. While searching the vehicle I observed clear plastic bag with two small clear plastic containers of a green leafy substance believed to be marijuana. With the needles belonging to [REDACTED] and the marijuana in the vehicle a complete search of the vehicle was conducted. No other drugs were found.

Inspector Foley searched [REDACTED] and Brendan Reilly with no drugs or weapons were found on their person. Officers asked [REDACTED] who was the black male he met with in the center, [REDACTED] stated, my friend Markus. [REDACTED] stated, he did not know his last name.

All parties were ran for Warrants.

Arlington Control informed units on scene of a active warrant on [REDACTED] Docket # [REDACTED] for Shoplifting, Ref # W8252000. [REDACTED] was transported to the station by Siempos (356) followed by Officer Conroy. At the station [REDACTED] was booked and afforded all his rights by Sgt Kiernan and fingerprinted by Officer Rob Pedrini. During booking [REDACTED] informed this Inspector that he was in the area to obtain Heroin, and his girlfriend was unaware. He also stated, he just met [REDACTED] and Reilly and was unsure if they obtained any illegal drugs while in Arlington Center.

The Marijuana was weighed at the station in the presence of Officer Pedrini at 2.6 Grams. [REDACTED] was issued Arlington Town By-Law control number 4659, Possession of Marijuana for \$100.00. Citation mailed to Mr. [REDACTED].

Marijuana was placed in evidence locker # 4
