NARRATIVE

On Friday February 15th 2013 at approximately 1721 hours while assigned to sector 3 I, Officer Kelley, responded to the area of Pond Lane for a report of a group of youths loitering on the bike path possibly with alcohol. Officer Savill, Sector 4, and Sgt Pedrini also responded.

While responding to the call Sgt Pedrini advised at 1731 hours that the group was walking East on the bike path from the Whittemeore St bridge. I responded to Linwood in an attempt to locate the parties. Officer Volkov, assigned to Traffic, radioed that he had observed 5 parties on the path traveling East. A short time later I made contact with the 5 parties about 100 feet west of Linwood on the bike path. Officer Wenz arrived on scene to assist. Sgt Pedrini arrived at 1737 hours and advised us that the group we were speaking with was the same group he had observed.

The 5 parties were Brendan Riley, [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and a party who identified himself as [REDACTED]. I requested WMS checks on all parties, and spoke with all 5 while we awaited results. All parties emptied their pockets voluntarily with no contraband found. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] both had backpacks on, and both consented to searches of their bags with no contraband found. They stated that they had been on the bike path in the area of the Arlington Boys and Girls Club when they exchanged words with another group of youths. They stated that they weren't looking to get into any trouble so they began walking east to the Alewife station.

Riley was wearing a blue and gray striped hooded sweatshirt and white sneakers. [REDACTED] was wearing a heavy black jacket. [REDACTED] was wearing dark clothing and a black and white Oakland Raiders hat. [REDACTED] was wearing a black winter coat with a red sweatshirt underneath and white sneakers with a Chicago Bulls hat.

Riley, [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] returned negative WMS and were allowed to leave. [REDACTED] came back as a possible warrant hit but with a different date of birth. Meserve had provided me with a date of birth of [REDACTED]-94 and the warrant returned to [REDACTED]-90. When asked to provide any information to help differentiate himself from the possible warrant [REDACTED] stated to me that he had a Mass ID card, but not on him. He stated he did not know his middle name, mothers name, address, or his social security number. I requested Dispatch conduct a search for [REDACTED] with the DOB of [REDACTED], and they were able to confirm [REDACTED] 94 out of [REDACTED] with two warrants. At this time while returning to speak to [REDACTED], Riley who was just leaving the area turned and stated to [REDACTED] "Good luck [REDACTED]". [REDACTED] was taken into custody at this time. He was placed in handcuffs (double-locked), pat searched for weapons, and placed in the rear of cruiser 351.

At the station [REDACTED] was booked and afforded all applicable rights as a person under arrest by Lt Conroy, Fingerprinted and searched by me, with Officer Kiernan assisting. While searching [REDACTED]'s backpack I located an E-Z Pass transponder that [REDACTED] stated belonged to his friend "Jimmy". He stated Jimmy had given it to him to sell.

Warrant 1249CR001189, issued by Framingham District Court for two counts ABDW and 1 count Malicious Destruction over 250.

Warrant 1210CR0015000, issued by Somerville District Court for one count of shoplifting.

[REDACTED]'s BOP contained 4 entries for the above charges.

I attempted to find information on the E-Z pass transponder, however the only information I could obtain from the website was that the pass was registered to an account. It was placed in an evidence bag, labeled, and placed in [REDACTED]
