On 11-27-13 at approx. 16:17hrs I, Car5 Officer French, Car2 Officer Isnor and Car4 Sgt Towle were dispatched to [REDACTED] for a report of a verbal domestic between a father and a son. I am familiar with address from past incidents.

Upon our arrival We met with [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] related that his son, 27 year old Brendon Reilly, is very agitated and is getting angrier because he won't give him \$30.00. Mr. [REDACTED] related that Brendon was arrested recently and someone else had bailed him out and Brendon owes that person \$30.00. Mr. [REDACTED] related that he told Brendon that he would talk to this person and pay him. Mr. [REDACTED] related that he does not want to give Brendon any money because he has drug problem and he doesn't want him to use the money to get drugs. Mr. [REDACTED] related that he is concerned that Brendon will become increasingly angry and may get violent or start breaking things around the house, as he has done in the past.

Mr. [REDACTED] related that Brendon knocked a basket of his things on to the floor but had not become aggressive towards him. Mr. [REDACTED] would like us to speak to Brendon and hopefully that will keep things calm for the Thanksgiving holiday.

Officer Isnor and I then went and spoke with Brendon in his bedroom. Brendon was very defensive towards us when we first entered the room. After speaking with Brendon for a few minutes he calmed down. Brendon finally related that he needed money to pay back his friend for the bail money he put up. We asked Brendon why would it be his father's responsibility to pay for his bail after his arrest. Brendon related that his father has been terrible to him his whole life and that his father owes him. I advised Brendon, that at 27 years old, he can change this situation. I advised Brendon that he is old enough to move out on his own and take care of himself. Brendon did not want to tell us why he recently was arrested. Brendon didn't even know why his father called the Police.


I advised Brendon, that with his past history of drug abuse, becoming violent and being destructive, that his father did the right thing to call us and diffuse the situation before it became a arrestable event. Brendon agreed. Brendon related that he won't speak to his parents the rest of the night and just stay in his room. Brendon related that he will be getting his monthly check for \$700.00 on Sunday and he will pay back his friend on Sunday. Officer Isnor pointed out to Brendon that he had a \$20.00 bill on his bed and that he would only need \$10.00 more to pay back his friend. Brendon related again that his friend will have to wait until he gets his check on Sunday.

I observed Brendon's room. There was drug paraphernalia in several places and several empty beer bottles. The room was messy, clothes and trash. It smelled of cigarettes. We did not observe any narcotics or weapons of any kind in plain view of the room.

We then spoke with Mr. [REDACTED] and advised him that Brendon will pay his friend on Sunday and not speak with his parents this evening. Mr. [REDACTED] asked if we could speak to Brendon in his presence about the situation. Officer Isnor had Brendon come down stairs. I advised both Brendon and Mr. [REDACTED] of what they both told me and advised them to do their best to get along for the Thanksgiving Day weekend. Brendon related that he will stay in his room and leave everyone else alone. Mr. [REDACTED] was satisfied with our response.

Officer safety: Brendon has been violent towards Police in the past. Use caution when dealing with him. Brendon was arrested in Arlington on 11-26-13 for allegedly showing his buttocks to students at Arlington High School.
