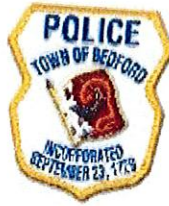

On 11-30-13 at approx. 01:30hrs I, Car5 Officer French, Car3 Officer Hunt and Car4 Sgt Wardwell were dispatched to [redacted] for a verbal domestic argument between a father and son. I am familiar with this address from previous incidents.

Upon our arrival we met with [redacted] and Brendan Reilly. We separated the two and I spoke with Brendan. Brendan related that he had been staying away from his parents for the most part over the holiday but had run out of cigarettes. Brendan related that his parents were out for most of the night and when they came home he knocked on their bedroom door and asked his father for a cigarette. Brendan related that his father did not give him a cigarette right away and they began yelling at each other. Brendan then related that his father finally gave him a cigarette and he went out on to the back deck to smoke it. Brendan related that the argument did not get physical.

We then met with Mr. [redacted]. Mr. [redacted] related that when he came home from a night out Brendan began pounding on his bedroom door demanding a cigarette. Mr. [redacted] related that he initially refused but Brendan would not stop and they began to argue. Mr. [redacted] finally gave Brendan a cigarette. Mr. [redacted] related that he is scared that his son is going to continue to get worse and more aggressive as the night and weekend goes on. Mr. [redacted] related that he is concerned that Brendan will become violent. Mr. [redacted] related that he does not want Brendan in the house anymore. Mr. [redacted] related that he would pay for a hotel room for Brendan. Sgt Wardwell had Emergency Communications Officer Newman contact the Bedford Motel and check on availability. There was a room available. I asked Brendan if he would go to a motel for the night. Brendan related that he would.

I escorted Brendan to his bedroom and he gathered a few items. I then transported Brendan to the Bedford Motel and paid the clerk with the \$85.00 Mr. [redacted] provided. I advised Brendan that he is not to go back to the home until he speaks to his parents by telephone. Brendan agreed to stay away from the house.

Sgt Wardwell and Officer Hunt advised Mr. [redacted] of his 209A Rights. Mr. [redacted] did not wish to get an emergency restraining order. Mr. [redacted] related that he will go to Concord District Court on Monday.
