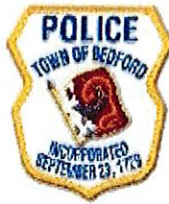

On 11/30/13 I, Officer Dineen car #11 responded to [redacted] upon Sgt. Barbieri's request to obtain Brendan Reilly's medication. Brendan had contacted the station and related he was concerned for his own mental well being and needed his medications that were at his house, Sgt. Barbieri and Off. Maloney were responding to the Bedford Motel to speak with Brendan directly. Brendan was transported to the Motel last evening/early this morning due to a domestic argument in the house. I am familiar with Brendan for various calls of service. These calls include domestics, drugs, investigations, missing person, check well being, fires, arrests, medicals, etc.

We have been to Brendan's home this past month several times in the past month and other occasions this year including, incident numbers 2013-12354, 2013-12352, 2013-12273, 2013-8089, 2013-8045, 2013-611, 2013-381.

Brendan is 27 years of age. He is low functioning and resides at home with his parents, he is diagnosed with Schizophrenia and personality disorders. In high school, Brendan was diagnosed as a Schizophrenic and was medicated. Brendan was treated in facilities on and off his entire life until now. Brendan's parents have re-mortgaged their home to have him receive treatment in a facility as far away as Vermont for his disorders and on going drug issues. Brendan medicates himself and abuses his prescription drugs. He sells them, trades them and buys other drugs with money given to him daily by his parents. Brendan receives \$700.00 monthly for disability from the State. Brendan is enrolled with the "Elliot house" and is seeing a councilor there. As to this date no treatments or facilities have provided any relief for Brendan or his family.

Today I spoke at length with Brendans mother, [redacted] was neutral with what was going on and appeared emotionless. [redacted] related that she was sorry she was not over come with joy to receive help for her son but she is so emotionally exhausted and spent that she is numb to the condition. [redacted] explained she has petitioned the court twice for a section 35, Drug and Alcohol abuse order for evaluation. [redacted] related that she cannot understand why, but that she was denied both times. [redacted] related that Brendan has taken over her entire life as well as her husbands. They sleep different times to stay awake to know what Brendan is doing and to stay safe. They have locked all the doors but he has broken them all off and goes through her personal items and areas looking for money or prescriptions, [redacted] has removed all breakable items from a China cabinet as Brendan breaks all her items on purpose and destroys the house, doors, personal items that he knows emotionally bother her and steals their car when he is under the influence of prescriptions and narcotics. [redacted] describes Brendan as "a threat to himself and to others".

[redacted] related that Brendan used to hear voices, but doesn't believe he does now. They have tried to work with agencies that keep him for in-house treatment but then release him after a two week stay. They have denied him to come home but he always does and she related that she is torn for the love of her son. [redacted] related again, without emotion, that she knows one day we (The Police Department) will be at her door to advise her and her husband that Brendan has killed himself or died from overdose. [redacted] related that she and her husband have had these conversations often and they know that is a possibility of what may happen to their son. [redacted] is heartbroken and feels that no one is listening to what they are trying to say of Brendan being a threat to himself and others. [redacted] related that Brendan cries often, threatens to kill himself often and the other day told her that he was going to hang himself. [redacted] related that no mother or person wishes these circumstances on themselves or anyone. That they never would of thought they would be in the situation they are in today.

On 8/21/13 incident #2013-8089, [redacted] Brendan's dad brought him to the station. Brendan had just burned down the rear attached porch of his grandmothers home and nearly burned the home down with people in it. Brendan had suffered burns and smoke inhalation as well and was under the influence at the time. At that time I sectioned 12 Brendan and he was transported to the Arbor way for two weeks treatment then released. The parents begged them not to release Brendan in fear for his life and theirs, but they did anyway. Please reference report #2013-8089 for Brendan's physical

condition and inability to care for himself.

Brendan has reportedly been diagnosed with Bipolar disorder and Schizophrenia. Brendan is a threat to his own health, is unable to process choices(driving without a license, drugs, indecent exposure, etc.) , health choices, overdoses on his own medications, is over medicated or under medicated, his mother stated to me that she cut off his services to DMH because they continuously provided prescriptions to Brendan even when they asked them not too. Brendan steals his parents cars when they are not home and operates the cars on the public roadways without a license under the influence of narcotics and prescriptions, he was recently arrested on 11/26/13 by the Arlington Police Department for Open and Gross Lewdness and Shoplifting on 9/20/13. These cases are open at this time.

██████ and ██████ have both admitted to being physically and mentally exhausted and unable to deal with the situation any longer. ██████ does not want Brendan in the house and feels he needs a group facility to reside in to have any type of a life. ██████ related she is on the verge just leaving the house herself to save what she feels she has left of her own sanity. ██████'s family are all done with dealing with Brendan's issues and it is causing extreme hardship on all the family immediate and extended.

At this time I am requesting to petition the court for a section 35, involuntary evaluation by the Concord District Court. Brendan is a known drug user, prescription abuser, violent individual who is unable to self care for himself, is a threat to the public with his actions of driving without a license and under the influence, is a criminal threat with recent Open and Gross charges and other charges, recently caused a house fire at a dwelling with persons inside and is not able to function in society on any level. Request for a Dangerousness hearing as well.

It is requested by Brendan's parents that he receive long term care within a facility that can manage and control his medications accordingly and provide housing to him for his safety and others. In speaking with Carol she is considering obtaining a refrain from abuse order and potentially a restraining order, banning Brendan from the home.

On 12/11/13 I, Officer Dineen car 3, responded to Concord District Court to petition for a section 35, involuntary committment for a Brendan Riley of 17 Reeves Road. The section 35 was issued by the Judge in effect until 4:30 on 12/12/13. The section was requested due to Brendan being a threat to himself and others, see previous report and incident #'s 2013-12352, 2013-12273, 3013-8089.

At this time I responded with Officer Devine, Sgt. Barbieri and Officer Maloney to 17 Reeves Road to take Brendan to court. Mr. ██████, Brendan's father met us there and brought us to Brendan's room, top of the stairs on the left hand side immediatly at the top. Brendan was in bed and became argumentative of the warrant and kept saying "you are fucking with me". Brendan was temoring and could not keep his hands still, but did not appear to be under the influence of anything at this time. Brendan was allowed to get dressed and gather a few belongings and he was then handcuffed, DL, and put in cruiser #3 for transport to Concord District Court. Brendan was aggravated during the transport and continued to say what we were doing was illegal and that we were lying. Brendan stated "you picked a bad day honey I am stable and sober right now, you should of waited until I was fucked up, they will never send me away now".
