On O2-26-14 at approximately 3:05PM, I Officer Maloney in marked cruiser number five and Officer Abajian in marked cruiser number three were dispatched to Avon Road for a white male dressed in blue shorts and a white tee shirt who was acting suspicious and running through back yards.

Upon arrival I made contact with Sgt. Towle and Sgt. Wardwell in the driveway of 7 Avon Road. Sgt. Towle related there were foot print tracks in snow leading to the rear of 8 Avon Road. I rushed over to the rear of 8 Avon Road where I encountered a white male who was dressed in blue shorts and a white tee shirt.

I immediately recognized the male to be Brendan Reilley who I have dealt with many times over the past six years. Brendan is known to have mental health issues. Brendan was knee deep in the snow and screaming for me to save him from the guys who were chasing him with guns.

I helped Brendan out of the snow and onto the cleared driveway. I immediately called for The Bedford Fire Rescue to respond because he was shivering uncontrollably and hullucinating. Brendan was wrapped in a blanket from my cruiser to keep him warm. I ask Brendan how long he was out in the cold and he related maybe an hour or two. I assured Brendan that everything was going to be ok and he calmed down immediately.

The caller related he did not see anyone chasing Brendan.

Bedford Fire Rescue arrived on scene and Brendan was treated and transported to Lahey Clinic due to exposure and a body temperature reading of 89 degrees. I accompanied Brendan in the ambulance to Lahey clinic.

No further Police action by me.
