## NARRATIVE FOR DETECTIVE SERGEANT MICHAEL J SALLESE

Ref: 15-47-AR

On Monday November 9, 2015 I was working the 7am to 3pm shift assigned to unmarked police cruiser 2. At approximately 10:10am I was dispatched to a 911 call from [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] reported that he is a worker at 219 Taylor Road, a group home house for the Advocates. [REDACTED] reported that REILLY, BRENDAN DOB 6/18/86 was misbehaving and just threw a hot cup of coffee at his face. I along with Officer Kusz and Stow Fire Department responded. While enroute I was undated by dispatch that the [REDACTED] was reporting that he has locked himself in his office, and that REILLY was banging on the office door.

Upon arrival I observed REILLY, who is known to me outside of 219 Taylor in the driveway pacing back and forth. I know REILLY from numerous interactions around town where he walks around public places and asks people for money. I have investigated REILLY for previous shoplifting charges, but the Store owner refused to press charges as he felt bad for REILLY's situation. I also know from previous interactions that REILLY has a criminal record, has a substance abuse problem, and has been assaultive toward police officers in the past.

I approached REILLY and asked him what was going on. I observed REILLY agitated, walking back and forth with his hands clenched. REILLY stated that the worker inside would not let him smoke and that he was upset. I asked REILLY if he threw any coffee on him. REILLY stated that he threw coffee next to the worker and never threw it on him.

I had an increased concern for my safety, and informed REILLY that for my safety I was handcuffing him (double-locked) and escorted him to my cruiser. I informed REILLY that he was not under arrest, but I was detaining him while I checked on the worker. REILLY became increasing upset, stating that the worker is just going to lie.

At this time Officer Kusz arrived on scene. We then went in and found the office door locked. I knocked on the door and announced presences. At this time a black male who was on the phone identified himself as [REDACTED]. I could hear [REDACTED] talking to the 911 operating informing him we were there. I also observed that [REDACTED] face was wet, along with his shirt and pants. I also observed on the floor a Dunkin Donuts Iced Coffee cup with the cap off of it.

I asked [REDACTED] what happened. [REDACTED] explained that REILLY has been the subject of recent house rules. He explained that REILLY has been smoking in his room which has caused the fire alarm to be set off. [REDACTED] explained that REILLY has to come to the office and request a cigarette and that REILLY can only smoke outside. [REDACTED] explained that REILLY came retrieved a cigarette, went outside then walked around the house to a separate entrance and went back to his room and smoke. [REDACTED] stated that REILLY then came again to the office and asked for another cigarette. [REDACTED] informed REILLY that he needed to stay outside and not go inside with the cigarette. [REDACTED] stated he gave REILLY the cigarette and again REILLY went back into his room to smoke.

[REDACTED] stated that on the third time REILLY appeared in his office, [REDACTED] explained to REILLY that he would give him the cigarette but would go outside with him and light the cigarette for him. [REDACTED] stated he was sitting on an office chair just ot he right of REILLY who was standing in the door way. [REDACTED] explained that REILLY became very upset yelling and screaming and him then threw the cup of coffee at him. [REDACTED] explained that when REILLY threw the coffee, the contents of the coffee exited the cup and landed on his face, stomach and legs. I asked [REDACTED] if the coffee was hot or cold and the container is usually used for ice coffee. [REDACTED] stated that the coffee was hot, as REILLY just completed making a pot of coffee in the kitchen. I observed the contents

of the cup were empty, but that there was a hot pot of coffee in the kitchen.

At this time Stow Fire Department arrived on scene and evaluated [REDACTED]. Lt. Guerin of the Stow Fire Department reported that he observed a change to [REDACTED]'s skin tone, approximately 2" inches in diameter above [REDACTED]'s right eye, which is constant with first degree burns. [REDACTED] did refuse medical treatment stating that he can not leave the house as he is responsible for the other tenants that are there.

I then returned to my cruiser, and I informed REILLY of his Miranda Rights, which I read to him in front of Officer Kusz. REILLY stated that he did not throw the coffee at him only next to him. I informed REILLY that he was under arrest for Assault and Battery Dangerous Weapon, which REILLY stated that I was over charging him.

I then transported REILLY to the Stow Police Station. Upon arrival REILLY requested to use the phone, which he made two phone calls and was able to make contact with his father. REILLY was then booked as per department procedure and policy.

REILLY was then transported to Concord Court.
