On November 23, 2016, I was working the evening shift as uniformed officer in marked cruiser #4 in the Town of Stow. Also working the shift was Sgt. Sallèse.

At approximately 7:04pm, I was dispatched to 219 Taylor Road for a report of a room that was broken into. It should be noted, 219 Taylor Road is owned by the company Advocates and individuals reside there who are in need of assistance.

On arrival, I was met in the driveway by Mr. ██████████ a resident, and ██████████ an Advocates employee. ██████████ stated he came home to find his bedroom door broken down (which was locked) and he had noticed someone had stolen his eighth of marijuana that he had in his drawer and approximately \$30.00 from his wallet. ██████████ stated he has a medical marijuana card and usually does not keep marijuana in the house (since it is not allowed according to staff members) but he decided to keep some in the house today. ██████████ stated he kept the marijuana in his dresser drawer in an orange pill container with his name on it. ██████████ stated he also had his wallet on his night stand with \$30.00 cash, which the cash is now missing. I then observed the bedroom door to be broken by the door handle and coming off its hinges.

██████████ stated he did not wish to press charges against anyone; he just wanted his stuff back. ██████████ stated he spoke with his supervisor and they do not wish to press charges; they will fix the door for ██████████ ASAP.

I asked ██████████ if he thought anyone in the residence would have stolen these items. ██████████ stated resident Brendan Reilly may have because "he always wants to get high". Also home at the time was residents' ██████████ ██████████ and ██████████ ██████████. At this time, I requested to speak with everyone who was home. ██████████ stated she did not wish to speak with me and she stayed in her bedroom. At that time, I spoke with ██████████ and Brendan. Both stated they did not hear anyone break down the door and did not know who could have taken the items. Brendan stated he thought ██████████ would break down his own door and say these things were missing so he could get more marijuana.

At this time, Brendan stated I could go into his bedroom to search for the missing items. I entered his bedroom and I was unable to locate the missing items. I also walked around the property and looked in various trash cans and did not find any of the missing items.

██████████ was advised to call again if he thought of any additional information that would be helpful. ██████████ stated he was unable to conduct room searches to locate the missing items due to company policy. ██████████ was also advised to call if he had any additional information.

Due to the filthy condition of Brendan's bedroom, I filed a Abuse Reporting Form with the Disabled Person's Protection Commission. I filed an oral report with the commission on November 23 (reference number CP 43197) and faxed the proper paperwork to the commission on November 28.

Nothing further at this time.
