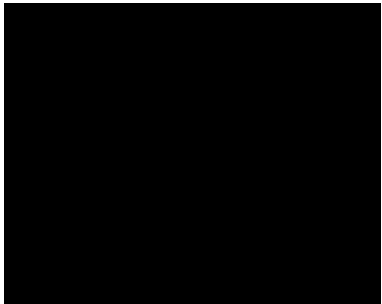

On December 1, 2016, I was working the evening shift as a uniformed officer in marked cruiser #4 in the Town of Stow. Also working the shift was Sgt. Sallese. The weather was cool, approximately 40 degrees, and dry.

At approximately 5:30pm, myself, Sgt. Sallese, and Stow Fire/EMS were dispatched to 219 Taylor Road for a report of a male party, later identified as [REDACTED], who was "huffing" cleaner and is unresponsive but breathing. It should be noted 219 Taylor Road is owned by Advocates and is a voluntary residential program for individuals who need assistance. On arrival, I was met outside by a staff member, [REDACTED], who stated [REDACTED] was now awake and sitting up in the staff office. I then went inside to evaluate [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated he didn't remember what happened and he just woke up on the floor. [REDACTED] also stated the last thing he remembered was being dropped off by someone in a car. Sgt. Sallese and Stow Fire/EMS then arrived.

I then spoke with the program director, [REDACTED], about what had happened. [REDACTED] stated he and several other staff members overheard [REDACTED] and another resident, Brendan Reiley, "huffing" canned computer duster. [REDACTED] stated he was able to get the can of "Perfect Duster" from them and he brought it into the staff office to prevent them from abusing it again. [REDACTED] stated then [REDACTED] walked into the staff office and took the can while staff were in the room. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] then sat on the couch in the living room and started huffing it again. [REDACTED] stated when [REDACTED] passed out on the couch he was able to get the can from [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated he brought it into the staff office again and threw it in the trash.

[REDACTED] stated all of a sudden, [REDACTED] shot up from the couch and started to charge towards him (when he was standing in the doorway of the kitchen near the staff office). [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] had his arms up, "like a bear would", and continued to charge towards him. [REDACTED] then reported Brendan grabbed onto [REDACTED] to prevent him from hitting him. [REDACTED] stated he thought if Brendan didn't hold [REDACTED] back he was going to strike him. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] did get close enough to wrap one arm around his upper body. It was then reported that [REDACTED] continued past [REDACTED] into the staff office where [REDACTED] was. [REDACTED] stated he pushed past him into the staff office to try to get the can of duster. [REDACTED] stated when [REDACTED] couldn't find it, he fell over onto the desk and landed on the floor. [REDACTED] stated when [REDACTED] checked on [REDACTED], he was unresponsive but was breathing and that was when they called 9-1-1.

It should be noted, through conversation with the staff members at Advocates, they expressed concern that [REDACTED] behavior has progressively become more violent since he's been at the house and could become more violent in the future. Staff members also expressed concern that the way [REDACTED] was able to push past them during this incident, they were fearful for their own safety when [REDACTED] is around them.

At this time, at the request of [REDACTED] legal guardian, it was decided he would be transported to Emerson Hospital for evaluation. Sgt. Sallese advised [REDACTED] he was under arrest for two counts of A&B and larceny from a person. I then followed the ambulance to Emerson Hospital.

At the hospital, I read [REDACTED] his Miranda Rights and he stated he understood them. [REDACTED] asked what he was being charged with and I explained it to him. [REDACTED] stated he didn't hit anyone. I then asked [REDACTED] to explain what happened. Initially [REDACTED] stated he did not remember what happened but then stated he wanted to tell me the truth. [REDACTED] stated Brendan told him he had something that would get him "lit". [REDACTED] stated he and Brendan then began to huff the duster in Brendan's room. [REDACTED] stated he passed out and he thought Brendan gave the staff the can when Brendan couldn't wake him up. [REDACTED] stated

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he then went into the staff office and got the can back. He stated he sat on the couch and "huffed" it until he passed out. [REDACTED] stated he thought the staff may have taken the can again when he blacked out so he got up to try to get it back again. [REDACTED] stated he tried to push the door open of the staff office and was able to get in and that was when he blacked out again. [REDACTED] denied any interaction with [REDACTED] or [REDACTED].

Sgt. Sallese contacted Bail Commissioner and bail was set at \$140.00. [REDACTED] made several phone calls to both his mother and father. [REDACTED] stated he could not find someone to bring him the bail money.

[REDACTED] was then evaluated by Dr. Frank at Emerson Hospital. After the doctor was complete, I then completed the booking process. During the booking process, [REDACTED] stated he was contemplating suicide and wanted to overdose. I immediately advised Dr. Frank and a hospital staff member was assigned to watch [REDACTED] as well. A mental health evaluator arrived and stated since [REDACTED] was under arrest, they could not evaluate him but she could call Advocates to do the evaluation.

At approximately 7:30pm, [REDACTED] asked to use the bathroom. The hospital staff member and myself escorted him to the bathroom. The bathroom was first checked for any route of escape and weapons. Myself and the staff member stayed right outside the door (within sound of him). After approximately 3-4 minutes, we checked on [REDACTED] and he did not answer. We then made entry into the bathroom to find [REDACTED] had his belt around his neck which was tied to a door handle. We then immediately took the belt off his neck and confirmed he was breathing and did have a pulse. Other hospital staff members arrived to assist. After approximately 30 seconds, [REDACTED] woke up and stated he was fine. [REDACTED] was then escorted back to his room and all his clothing items and belongings were put into a bag and he put on a hospital johnny. [REDACTED] was also handcuffed to the hospital stretcher.

At approximately 9:00pm, [REDACTED] was discharged medically from the hospital and the hospital staff stated Advocates will complete their mental health evaluation at Stow PD.

[REDACTED] was transported to the Stow PD without incident. On arrival at the station, [REDACTED] was photographed and fingerprinted. [REDACTED] also requested to use the telephone again, which he did. [REDACTED] stated again that he could not find someone to bring him bail money. [REDACTED] then changed from his clothing into a jump suit and placed in cell #2.

At approximately 9:50pm, Sgt. Sallese spoke with [REDACTED] from Advocates who was requesting an update on [REDACTED]. Mr. Pellergrine stated he did not believe [REDACTED] needed an evaluation done tonight (C123 s18) since he was sleeping, calm and waking him may aggravate [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated the process to complete the evaluation could take the majority of the night and he did not believe it was appropriate since we [the Stow PD] could keep him safe until morning.
