On Monday July 13, 2020 at approximately 0135hrs while assigned to T-1 on the overnight I, Officer Weisenborn, was dispatched to 17 Reeves Road for a medical.

On arrival I spoke with Brendan Reilly 06/18/1986. Reilly related that he was recently infected with HIV. Reilly explained that he was in [redacted]'s backyard [redacted] Bedford, MA) when [redacted] took a vial of HIV and poked him (Reilly) in the back of the neck with it. Reilly explained that he knows that he has the infected based on the way he feels. He was unable to elaborate. I did not observe any marks on Reilly's neck that would indicate that he was stuck with anything. Reilly related that this occurred 10 days ago. Reilly also explained that he overheard a conversation that his mother was having. Reilly related that due to this conversation he knows that she paid Stephen to infect him. The infection has not been confirmed by a doctor at this point.

Prior to transport to the hospital I requested to pat-frisk Reilly. Reilly agreed. Negative results. Reilly was transported to Emerson Hospital via Bedford Medic-1 to be tested for HIV. I followed the ambulance to Emerson Hospital. Emerson Hospital security was notified.
