1. On Thursday, 01/26/2023 at approximately 1400 hrs, I, Trooper Murgo spoke with Tavery HUTCHINSON ([REDACTED]/1968) as part of the investigation into the death of Brendan REILLY. Tavery HUTCHINSON stated the following: Tavery HUTCHINSON was driving her son, Ryan HUTCHINSON, to a basketball game at the Diamond Middle School in Lexington on 02/12/2022. Tavery HUTCHINSON had entered the rotary that is comprised of N. Hancock St., Burlington St., Blake Rd, Hancock St., and Hamilton Rd. During this time, a confrontation between the Police and REILLY was taking place. Ryan HUTCHINSON was in the front passenger seat while Tavery HUTCHINSON was operating the vehicle. Tavery HUTCHINSON was focused on the road and only briefly observed Police Officer's with their firearms pointed at REILLY. Tavery HUTCHINSON then made several attempts to try to avoid this confrontation while her son Ryan was observing and recording the incident. Tavery HUTCHINSON heard at least two gunshots while they were driving away from the rotary. Tavery HUTCHINSON stated that once the basketball game concluded later in the evening, the scene had cleared and there was no Police presence. All video and images captured by Ryan HUTCHINSON have been submitted to the Middlesex District Attorney's Office.
