On Tuesday, January 5, 2021, at approximately 1430, I responded to Newton to assist in the above investigation. Upon arrival at 18 Lincoln Street, I was joined by Lieutenant Robert Dateo, Sergeant Colleen Tanguay, and Trooper Stephanie Devlin of MSP Crime Scene Services Section. We met with case officer, Trooper Mark Delaney of the MSP Middlesex County Detective Unit.


Lieutenant Dateo (Crime Scene Services Executive Officer) provided managerial case oversight and liaison services while on scene. Sergeant Tanguay served as scene supervisor and prepared the scene sketch. Trooper Devlin provided video documentation of the scene.

I documented the scene with digital photography and processed two articles of evidence on scene, which consisted of a wooden box and the handle of a silver colored box located on the rear porch of the third floor for friction ridge impressions. After processing, no friction ridge impression(s) of value was observed. I then secured two items and transported them to the Maynard Laboratory for processing.

On Wednesday, January 06, 2021, while at the Crime Scene Laboratory in Maynard, I processed and analyzed the following items for friction ridge impressions. Below is a conclusion of my results:

- 1-2 Knife recovered from 18 Lincoln Street, 3rd floor hallway  
Qty: 1  
After processing, no friction ridge impression(s) of value was observed.
- 1-3 Other cigarette package  
Qty: 1  
After processing, no friction ridge impression(s) of value was observed.
