Studies have shown that students' physical and emotional well-being directly impacts their performance in school. Enrollment in this program will help children to learn lasting oral hygiene habits, receive preventative care and reduce absence from school.

- All students in grades 2 and 5 will learn how to brush, floss, and eat healthy.
- Families can sign their students up to have free preventative dental work (such as oral screenings, dental sealants, fluoride treatments) done at their school or local dental clinic.
- Forms will be sent home soon for families to sign-up.
