SUBJECT: NEWTON - OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING, MICHAEL CONLON

1. On Tuesday, January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021, at 1422 hours, Sergeant Sean O'Brien notified me of a police involved shooting. I was advised that the scene was at 18 Lincoln Street in Newton.
2. I responded to the scene and arrived at 18 Lincoln Street along with Sergeant Sean O'Brien and Lieutenant William Donoghue. Trooper James Connolly arrived a short time later and managed the scene. I learned that Michael CONLON (DOB 7/9/1992) was the suspect. CONLON was actively being removed from the building by paramedics and lifesaving measures were ongoing. CONLON was eventually transported to the hospital where he was later pronounced deceased.
3. I, Lieutenant Donoghue and Sergeant O'Brien walked up to the third floor via the rear staircase. We met with Detective Sergeant John O'Connell of the Newton Police Department and were later joined by Captain Paul Bulman. We learned the following preliminary information: CONLON allegedly walked into the candy store (Indulge Candy Chocolates) and spoke to an employee named Linda Gulman (DOB [REDACTED]/1962). CONLON was armed with a knife. Linda called 911 at 1343 hours. Dispatchers notified officers of a robbery in progress. Officers arrived on scene and observed CONLON on the sidewalk in front of 18 Lincoln Street. CONLON retreated into the apartment building at 18 Lincolns Street. Officers pursued CONLON to the third floor of 18 Lincoln Street where the shooting took place. There were numerous Newton Police officers involved in the encounter. There was also two Massachusetts State Trooper involved.

4. I spoke with the two Troopers who identified themselves as:

Trooper Christian Howell, ID 4529 (H4 Barracks)  
Trooper Dylan Finerty, ID 4304 (C2 Barracks)

I learned that Finerty deployed his taser and fired it one time. Trooper Howell was on the third floor with Trooper Finerty but did not fire his taser. Both Troopers were taken to the hospital for evaluation and will speak with investigators later.

5. While on scene I spoke with Danielle Kalfon (DOB [REDACTED]/1968), Casey Murtagh (DOB [REDACTED]/1994) and [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]/1993) of 18 Lincoln Street (see interview reports). I also conducted a neighborhood canvass along with Detective Steve Fontano (see canvass report). Trooper Connolly and Detective Peter Koerber also conducted a canvass (see additional canvass report). I was advised by the Newton Police Department that all firearms were secured in Newton police cruiser 508.

6. In speaking with Casey and [REDACTED] I learned that the owner of the building is Hamilton Company. Casey provided me with the phone number to the front office (617-783-0039). I called Hamilton Company and asked for a consent to search the common areas of the building. They advised me that [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]) is the manager of the property and could provide consent. I then spoke with [REDACTED] over the phone. [REDACTED] had just left the scene but gave verbal consent to search the common areas. [REDACTED] then returned to the scene and provide written consent, which was obtained by Detective Peter Koerber (see attached consent form).

7. After conducting interviews at the Newton Police Detective Bureau, I returned to the scene at approximately 1940 hours. Trooper Hughes of Ballistics and Trooper Comeau of the Crime Scene Services Section were recovering an additional casing that was located under the ottoman and a projectile that was recovered from Danielle's Kaflon's apartment. I secured for the night at approximately 2300 hours.

8. On January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021, I returned to the scene at approximately 1100 hours. I met with Trooper Anthony Delucia and Sergeant Sean O'Brien to review the scene. I then continued and completed the Canvass of the surrounding area (see Canvass report). At approximately 1230 hours, Sergeant O'Brien informed me that a maintenance worker had located an additional projectile in the rug of the common hallway on the third floor. Trooper Dave Hughes of Ballistics and Trooper Zack Clark of the Crime Scene Services Section arrived on scene to photograph and retrieve the projectile. I also gave Trooper Hughes an unspent less lethal shotgun round that Newton Police recovered from the hospital. At 1500 hours I cleared the scene. Trooper Delucia and Sergeant O'Brien began conducting the police interviews.

9. On January 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021, I travelled to the Newton Police Department and met with Lieutenant George McMains at 1130 hours. I took custody of one evidence bag containing a fire extinguisher. The evidence was transported to the State Police SPDU office in Woburn and placed into evidence. The investigation into the facts and circumstances of the shooting of Michael Conlon continues.

1. [REDACTED] On Tuesday, January 5, 2021 at approximately 1700 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] in Medfield to make the death notification of Michael Conlon. Also present with me was Chief Michelle Guerette and Sergeant Ryan Maxfield of the Medfield Police Department.
2. [REDACTED] informed us his son suffered from Schizophrenia and was also diagnosed as a juvenile as Bi-polar. He stated he was on numerous medications for his condition and has been under psychiatric care for a long time. Most recently he was seeing Dr. John Halprin, through Zoom meetings on a bi-weekly basis. He told us he has been treated at Mclean Hospital in the past. He also was at an inpatient care facility in California approximately 9 years ago where he stayed for over 2 years.
3. [REDACTED] told us Michael was home this past weekend on Thursday and he drove him back to his apartment in Newton yesterday, January 4, 2021. He said Michael was recently prescribed a new medication, he believes started with a "p". He said he took 4 of these pills on Thursday (12/31/20) and that Michael was acting weird. [REDACTED] told us it was causing Michael to

shuffle his feet on the floor and he was often staring up into the ceiling. He was unable to provide me with the exact name of the prescription. [REDACTED] said he seemed back to normal on Saturday and seemed normal on Monday when he drove him to his apartment.

4. [REDACTED] told us that Michael told him while at home this past weekend that he had a knife at his apartment. He also told us that when Michael used to live at home he would notice steak knives would go missing from the kitchen. He said he would find them in Michael's bedroom. Michael would tell him he was paranoid people were coming after him. [REDACTED] provided me with his last communication with Michael that occurred on January 4, 2021 in which Michael states he believes people are really after him this time. (See attached photo)

SUBJECT: AUTOPSY OF MICHAEL CONLON

1. On December 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021, I attended the autopsy of Michael Conlon at the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner's office in Boston. The autopsy was conducted by Dr. Christina Stanley. Prior to the autopsy, OCME technicians assisting in the case located a taser probe on Conlon's jacket. The probe was secured as evidence along with his clothing.

2. During the autopsy, Dr Stanley noticed 9 distinct gunshot wounds. The rounds to Conlon's torso struck the right lung, diaphragm, and liver. The round to his neck may have struck a major artery.

3. Dr Stanley said that the cause of death will be "Multiple gunshot wounds" and the manner is "homicide".

1. On, Tuesday, January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021, I became involved in the officer involved shooting of Michael CONLON (DOB 7/9/1992). The shooting took place on the third floor of 18 Lincoln Street in Newton. While on scene I was notified that a woman named Dani, who works at Salon Capri, may have been a witness.

2. I crossed the street and walked into Salon Capri. I was met by Danielle KALFON (DOB [REDACTED]/1968). I asked her if there was a Dani in the building. KALFON said that her friends call her Dani. I asked if she had seen any of the events that occurred at 18 Lincoln Street this afternoon. KALFON stated the following: She lives at 18 Lincoln Street, in unit #3, on the third floor. She was at work all day when she received a phone call from her friend [REDACTED] who works at Indulge Chocolate. [REDACTED] told KALFON that Michael was in her store with a knife and was looking for her. KALFON stated that she walked over to Indulge Chocolate and briefly spoke to [REDACTED]. She then returned to work. KALFON did not observe any of the events that occurred inside 18 Lincoln Street.

3. I asked KALFON who Michael was. KALFON stated that Michael lives on the second floor of her building. She described Michael as having mental health issues. KALFON was friendly with Michael as she would say hello if she saw him in the hallway or smoking cigarettes by the back door. She had never had more than a brief conversation with him. KALFON stated that she had filed a noise complaint with the building owner against Michael a few months ago. KALFON stated that Michael would be up all night banging the cabinets and throwing things around his apartment. After KALFON made the complaint she received a four-page letter from Michael. In the letter, Michael apologized for disturbing KALFON with the noise. Michael said that it was the ghost making the noise and not him. KALFON said that she may still have the letter and would try to find it. This concluded the interview.

SUBJECT: NEWTON - THE INTERVIEW OF CASEY MURTAGH (█/1994) AND  
MATT MELIA (█/1993)

1. On Tuesday, January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021, at approximately 1600 hours, while investigation the police involved shooting of Michael CONLON, I met with Casey MURTAGH (DOB █/1994, cell # █) and █ (DOB █/1993, cell # █). I first met them on the sidewalk in front of Salon Capri (31 Lincoln Street). █ and MURTAGH stated that they lived in unit #4, located on the third floor of 18 Lincoln Street. MURTAGH stated that she was in the apartment at the time of the incident involving CONLON. █ stated that he was at work during the incident but was talking to MURTAGH on speaker phone and heard everything that happened. The first half of our interview occurred on scene. The second half of the interview occurred when they transported themselves to the Newton Detective Unit to continue the interview at approximately 1800 hours. Detective Stephen Fontano was present for the interview at the Newton Detective Unit.

2. I first spoke with MURTAGH who stated the following: MURTAGH was home, in apartment #4, when she heard banging and unintelligible screaming on the stairs at approximately 1:45 p.m. She then heard banging on her neighbor's door (unit #3, rented by Danielle (Dani) KALFON, DOB █/1968). She remembered that the sound of the banging was distinctive because it sounded like it was a blunt object striking the door...not a hand or fist. MURTAGH then opened her apartment door and saw CONLON banging on KALFON's door. MURTAGH quickly closed her door and locked it. MURTAGH did not have her glasses on and could not say if she saw a knife or not. After closing her door, she heard the police saying, "put the knife down". She heard CONLON

saying “Dani, Dani, call my real dad, [REDACTED] are you in on this?.....I know you are in there Dani. This is a simulator.” CONLON continued to scream about being in a simulation and that he wanted the FBI because the FBI knows what is happening and they are in on the simulation. CONLON sounded desperate for help and the police were trying to calm CONLON down. MURTAGH then heard CONLON say “you come close I’ll kill you and myself” .....”you are not real cops”.

3. MURTAGH then looked out her window and saw KALFON standing on the sidewalk with the police. MURTAGH went to her back door, where she saw police standing on her back deck. She opened her back door to the deck and talked to a plain clothes police officer. She told them that there was a situation in the hallway, and they could use her apartment to access the hallway. MURTAGH then left her apartment and asked the police if she could stay on KALFON’s deck with the police because she was scared. MURTAGH then overheard the police looking for a crowbar. She told the police that she had some tools and led the police back into her apartment living room to show them where she kept the tools. While she was in the living room, she observed a police officer open the door to the hallway to see the situation. At this time MURTAGH got scared and walked back to KALFON’s deck, where she was with other police officers. While she was on the deck, a police officer asked her “do you know who Dani is”. She explained to the officer that Dani lived in apartment #3. The officer then pointed to the door from KALFON’s porch and asked MURTAGH if she knew where the door led to. MURTAGH said that she had no idea where the door led to. At this time MURTAGH said she realized she was in a dangerous situation and asked the police if she could leave down the back stairs. One police officer said, “this isn’t going to end well”, which MURTAGH understood as “yes you should go”. MURTAGH then exited out the rear of the building. MURTAGH stated that she heard six gunshots as she was leaving the building.

4. MURTAGH called [REDACTED] on her cell phone at 1:47 p.m. MURTAGH had [REDACTED] on speaker phone and [REDACTED] was able to hear part of the event. [REDACTED] stated that he heard part of what CONLON was saying, just as MURTAGH had described it. [REDACTED] added that it “sounded like he (CONLON) was going to hurt the cops. [REDACTED] could not specifically say why felt that way, but it was just the sense he had.

5. MURTAGH had typed up notes from her memory of the event. She forwarded me the notes via email (see attached). MURTAGH and [REDACTED] advised me that they would be staying in a hotel for the evening. [REDACTED] stated he is the lessee of the apartment and signed a consent form to search apartment #4 (see attached). The interview concluded.

SUBJECT: NEWTON - NEIGHBORHOOD CANVASS

1. On Tuesday, January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021, I became involved in the investigation into the fatal police shooting of Michael CONLON (DOB 7/9/1992) in the city of Newton. As part of the investigation, I joined up with Detective Stephen Fontano and conducted a canvass of the surrounding businesses on Lincoln Street. Below are the results of the canvass:

#23 Lincoln Street, Cacas Coffee Shop, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]) – [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] work at Cacas Coffee Shop. They stated that they did not see or hear anything unusual. All the security cameras for the coffee shop face into the store.

#25 Lincoln Street, Jarbo- The store was closed.

#27 Lincoln Street, Anna's Taqueria- We spoke to all the employees who were working at the time of the incident. No one saw anything unusual. All surveillance cameras only capture the inside of the store.

#31 Lincoln Street, Salon Capri- We spoke with Danielle Kalfon (DOB [REDACTED]/1968), which was documented in an interview report. All other employees did not see or hear anything unusual. There were no security cameras in the salon.

#33 Lincoln Street, Highland Opticians, was closed.

#35 Lincoln Street, Bfitt60, was closed.

#39 Lincoln Street, Anthony Andrews Jewelers, [REDACTED], DOB [REDACTED]/56, [REDACTED] – [REDACTED] stated that he saw all the police cars arriving and he went outside to see what was going on. He was standing in front of his store when he heard six gun shots. He did not see anything else significant.

#32 Lincoln Street, [REDACTED], DOB [REDACTED]/1960, [REDACTED] – [REDACTED] is the owner of the store which bears her name. She did not see anything unusual and does not have any security cameras.

#28 Lincoln Street, Bleiler Jewelers – closed.

#26 Lincoln Street, Davis Hairdressing, [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]) – [REDACTED] stated that they did not see or hear anything unusual and they do not have any cameras.

#22 Lincoln Street, Adamas Jewelers, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], stated they were both on the first floor of the store when they noticed the police activity outside. [REDACTED] stated that they “heard Linda talking to the Police”. Both employees stated that they heard “three or four” shots in rapid succession, which [REDACTED] stated “might have been bean bags”. Employee [REDACTED] was on the second floor of the store and stated that she heard the shots and that it was “more than three”. [REDACTED] stated that he had previously interacted with a bearded man in the back of the building. The bearded man would sit on the back stairs smoking cigarettes. [REDACTED] never had an issue with him.

#20 Lincoln Street, Walnut Food Market – closed.

2. On Wednesday, January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021, I returned to Lincoln Street to complete the canvass.

#6 Lincoln Street, Grape Leaf, [REDACTED], DOB [REDACTED]/1998, [REDACTED] – [REDACTED] stated that she did not hear or see anything unusual yesterday. They do not have cameras in the store.

All interviewees were asked to contact detectives if they learned of any new information regarding the incident.

SUBJECT: CRIME SCENE- 18 LINCOLN ST, NEWTON

1. On the afternoon of January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021, I was assigned to assist in the investigation of the officer involved shooting of Michael Conlon at 18 Lincoln St, Newton. Based off preliminary information gained and evidence observed by investigators, it appeared that Conlon was shot on the third-floor common area/ hallway of 18 Lincoln St. He was later pronounced deceased at Newton Wellesley Hospital.

2. I noted that 18 Lincoln St. is a multi-unit apartment complex above two stores; 'Indulge!' (16 Lincoln St) and 'Walnut Food Market' (20 Lincoln St). The main entrance to the apartments is nestled in between the aforementioned storefronts. Once inside, there are stairs up to the apartments. The staircase runs up the center of the building. There is also a rear staircase that has access to the common area of the apartment building and each individual apartment's rear porch. The 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the building has apartments #1 and #2. The 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the building has apartments #3 and #4. Through the course of the investigation, we learned that Conlon lived in apartment #1 and another relevant person, Danielle Kalfon, lived in apartment #3.

3. Written consent was obtained by investigators for the common area of the apartment building, apartment #1, apartment #3 and apartment #4 (documents attached to case). There was a small amount of blood in the second-floor common area, but most of the blood was on the third-floor common area and landing. There was also medical equipment on the landing of the third floor. Spent casings, projectiles and/or fragments were recovered from the third-floor common area as well



as in apartments #3 and #4. A deployed taser cartridge and leads, a less lethal shotgun and several less lethal rounds were secured from apartment #4 and the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor common area. Please refer to documentation by the Crime Scene Services Section, Firearms Identification Section and Collision Analysis and Reconstruction Section for exact locations of these items throughout the scene.

4. While on scene, I learned that Newton Police had secured a knife from Conlon after he was shot and it was secured as evidence.

5. Detective Lieutenant Dateo, Sergeant Colleen Tanguay, Trooper Comeau and Trooper Devlin, of the Crime Scene Services Section (CSSS) documented the scene with digital photography and video. Trooper John Cronin and Trooper Jake Conant, of the Collision Analysis and Reconstruction Section (CARS), documented the scene with Total Station. Lieutenant Dave Cahill Trooper Dave Hughes, of the Firearms Identification Section (Ballistics/ FIS) documented and secured any ballistic evidence.

6. During the examination and documentation of the scene, investigators noticed that the rear door from Danielle Kalfon's apartment (#3) to her rear porch appeared to have been barricaded with items on the porch. Trooper Gary Comeau attempted to fingerprint some the items after documenting them with digital photography, but was not able to obtain any prints. I called and requested a Forensic Scientist from the State Police Crime Lab. Forensic Scientist Kelly King came and swabbed two items leaned against the door for DNA. She also took swabs of two separate red/brown stains from the third-floor common area.

7. CSSS documented Conlon's apartment (#1). After they had documented the apartment, I observed an Apple iPhone in the kitchen. I secured the phone for later examination by investigators.

SUBJECT: CANVASS OF 1-21 LINCOLN ST

1. On the evening of January 5, 2021, I was assigned to assist in the police officer involved shooting of Michael Conlon at 18 Lincoln St, Newton. During the investigation, Detective Peter Koerber and I conducted a canvass of Lincoln St, between #1-21. These addresses were across the street from the 18 Lincoln St. and the 'Indulge!' candy shop.
2. 1-7 Lincoln St was closed.
3. The first open shop we came upon was 9 Lincoln St; Lux Couture. The employees reported that they had been doing a clothing photo shoot and only noticed that multiple police cars flooded the street. They had not heard or seen anything leading up to the large police presence.
4. At 15 Lincoln St, Otake Sushi Bistro, the employees said that they had not heard or seen anything leading up the police presence on Lincoln St.
5. 17 Lincoln St. was closed.
6. At 19 Lincoln St, Frank's Barber Shop, we spoke with [REDACTED]. He said that he had a customer, [REDACTED], when he noticed flashing blue lights. He looked up and saw Michael Conlon standing in front of Indulge!/ 18 Lincoln St. He said that upon seeing the blue lights, Conlon ran into 18 Lincoln St. and uniformed police officers ran after him. He said that he

turned the barber's chair towards the window so that [REDACTED] could see what was happening and he continued to cut his hair. After about 45 minutes, [REDACTED] said that he had heard gunshots. [REDACTED] said that he had not heard the gunshots. [REDACTED] said that he knows Conlon because he is always hanging around outside smoking cigarettes by a tree in front of 18 Lincoln St. He said that he had cut Conlon's hair a few times and added that Conlon seemed to have some mental illness.

7. I called and spoke with [REDACTED]. He said that, when he arrived on Lincoln St, there were already police cruisers on the street. He saw two uniformed State Troopers walking down the street and entering the building across from Frank's Barber Shop. He said he never saw the man who was ultimately shot and thought he may have heard the gunshots while getting his haircut, but was not completely sure.

8. At 21 Lincoln St, Garden City Vape and Smoke Shop, I spoke with [REDACTED], who said that he saw blue lights and then heard a few gunshots about 45 minutes after he first noticed the lights. The glass on the front of the shop is frosted well over head height due to a town by-law on his shop. The frosted glass makes it impossible to see the door to 18 Lincoln St. without making significant effort. [REDACTED] said that he knows Conlon because he comes in frequently to buy cigarettes. [REDACTED] added that Conlon seems to have some type of mental illness.

9. All people contacted during the canvass were asked to contact the police if they or anyone else had any relevant information regarding the incident.

[REDACTED] stated the following: [REDACTED] was walking on the sidewalk on her way to Anna's Taqueria. She believed the time to be 1343 hours, because she had just called a friend. At this time, she looked across the street and observed a man holding a knife. She stated the knife was the size of an "x-acto blade". She described the man holding the knife as "a white man in his 30's, who looked like a crack head". The man was wearing a mask (for COVID). She became nervous and went into the store, which was across the street from the man with the knife.

3. From inside the store, she observed a police officer arrive on scene and confront the man with the knife on the sidewalk. The police officer yelled for the man to "put down the knife" at least three times. The man with the knife yelled "get away from me". She then observed the man enter the building and the police followed. At this time, she texted [REDACTED] who owns the chocolate store. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] is a friend of her parents.
