- On the evening of the 4<sup>th</sup>, around approximately SEBASTIAN: 1 9:30 maybe, I got a text message saying that all SWAT 2 members are to muster at the Framingham Police Department 3 at approximately 11:00. Um, we got there. I got all my 4 gear together and it took a little while for the Deputy 5 Davis and Sergeant Stuart, Lieutenant Downing, to come 6 downstairs and tell us what our mission was going to be for 7 the night. I think it happened around quarter of 11 -- I'm 8 sorry, quarter of 12, 12:00, and my job that night was to 9 drive the SWAT vehicle from the station to Fountain Street 10 and my orders were to stop approximately 30 yards before 11 the target house, turn my lights off when I got on to 12 Fountain Street and park right next to the gas station 13 [inaudible]. At that time, um, my job was to be assigned 14 with Officer Duncan and Sergeant Stuart. Officer Duncan's 15 responsibility was to reach the door -- do you want me to -16 17 Yeah, we're going to give you -- you got a picture of FOSTER: 18

Q2; Yeah, we do.

- I think we've got everything. What do you need first? FOSTER: 21
- Just to show you how I walked into the house. SEBASTIAN: 22

the house there? Oh, we don't have all those?

- 1 FOSTER: All right. Do you have the front door? All right.
- Just a second. We're going to be needing more of those
- probably. You want the outside?
- 4 SEBASTIAN: No, I can do just the door going in so I can tell
- 5 you.
- 6 FOSTER: [Inaudible; overlapping dialogue] feel better if I
- 7 gave you the outside of the house, if that's all right, OK?
- And you can just explain. You've got a pen there.
- 9 SEBASTIAN: I don't think we had any other doors.
- 10 FOSTER: We need to get more stuff. Is that good enough for
- 11 your purposes right now?
- 12 SEBASTIAN: Yeah. All right, as they approached the house,
- there was a black female exiting. I don't know who she
- 14 was. She was in crawl position right here.
- 15 FOSTER: What do you mean crawl? She had already been secured
- 16 by?
- 17 SEBASTIAN: I'm not sure if she was secured or not. She was
- right here laying down and this window was breached and I
- 19 know that from obviously the pre-briefing of the
- 20 lieutenant. So I went in through the door and there was a
- 21 door right here.
- 22 FOSTER: So you made entry?
- 23 SEBASTIAN: Mm-hmm.

- 1 FOSTER: All right. Can you just tell me like were you one of
- 2 the first ones or --?
- 3 SEBASTIAN: No I wasn't. I was -- I think I was the last
- one, but so Officer Duncan was to breach the door inside.
- 5 So if you have a picture of the hallway.
- 6 Q2: We don't. I don't think so.
- 7 FOSTER: Yup. I don't know if we have one on that.
- 8 SEBASTIAN: So this -- right to the right of this door --
- 9 FOSTER: There's a room. I know that there's like a stairway
- 10 and then the rooms, OK.
- 11 SEBASTIAN: That door Officer Duncan breached. After he
- 12 breached it, he went through.
- 13 FOSTER: I'm sorry. When you say breached the front door or
- the door to the bedroom?
- 15 SEBASTIAN: The door of the bedroom. See this room right
- 16 here?
- 17 FOSTER: Yeah, OK there was a door that he -- OK. All right.
- 18 SEBASTIAN: So the door was breached. Officer Duncan and
- 19 Sergeant Stuart went in. I followed. Um, there was nobody
- in there. The room kind of led around and I saw like a
- 21 black blanket that was shaped up on the ceiling or I don't
- 22 know how it was secured and that's where Officer Duncan and
- 23 Sergeant Stuart were. At that time I came back around

- through the door and up the hallway into the kitchen right
- 2 here. To my left was Lieutenant Downing and --
- 3 FOSTER: Can we just stop for one second there. Before when
- you, um, when you were the last one in, so were you
- 5 actually in the truck when everybody started going in?
- 6 SEBASTIAN: To get out of the truck is kind of a pain in the
- neck because it's not easy to get out because you have to
- find the latch. Everything's dark. It's kind of an older
- 9 vehicle.
- 10 FOSTER: Yup. So was the entry already made by the time you
- got over there? Did they already knock and announce? Did
- 12 you hear any of that?
- 13 SEBASTIAN: Sergeant Stuart, he announced Framingham Police
- and then the simultaneous bangs went into the house. I was
- the last one in, though.
- 16 FOSTER: OK, all right, all right.
- 17 SEBASTIAN: I'm 99% sure. So if you're looking at this
- picture right here, this is the room I was in.
- 19 FOSTER: I know where you're talking about.
- 20 SEBASTIAN: So I came around and when I came here, all right,
- 21 Lieutenant Downing was standing right --
- 22 FOSTER: Why don't you X like where you were when you came in
- 23 here. What was there?

- 1 SEBASTIAN: I was right here.
- 2 FOSTER: OK.
- 3 SEBASTIAN: So do you want me to right Lieutenant Downing?
- 4 FOSTER: Yeah and your name too, where you were. This was
- after you had already came in, went into that room and then
- 6 went back around into the hallway?
- 7 SEBASTIAN: Yeah.
- 8 FOSTER: OK.
- 9 SEBASTIAN: They seemed to be jammed up at that area right
- here. They like -- I'm not sure if they were pulling that
- 11 blanket down or what or going behind it, but I knew that
- 12 they were --
- 13 Q2: By they, you mean?
- 14 SEBASTIAN: I'm sorry. Sergeant Stuart and Lieutenant -- I'm
- sorry. Sergeant Stuart and Officer Downing.
- 16 Q2: Officer Duncan?
- 17 SEBASTIAN: Officer Duncan, yeah, sorry.
- 18 FOSTER: Oh, you mean when you went into that other room,
- 19 Sergeant Downing and Officer Duncan were in that room?
- 20 SEBASTIAN: Officer Duncan and Sergeant Stuart.
- 21 FOSTER: Sergeant Stuart.
- 22 SEBASTIAN: I followed them in. I apologize.
- 23 FOSTER: That's all right.

- 1 SEBASTIAN: I said the wrong names. So I came back around
- and Lieutenant Downing was right here and I was right
- 3 there.
- 4 FOSTER: And when you came back around, those other two
- officers stayed in that room, as far as you know?
- 6 SEBASTIAN: Um, I'm not sure. I think what they were doing
- is they were meeting up with the other officers. They had
- already come through here. So everybody had met up. So I
- g came back around and I believe Sergeant Louis was here
- holding this stairwell up here because we just didn't want
- anything to come down on the scene. So he's not a SWAT
- member. He was a midnight sergeant that assisted. Right
- at this particular time, Lieutenant Downing, when he came
- 14 around, said we need to clear the cellar.
- 15 FOSTER: OK.
- 16 SEBASTIAN: All right and Officer Riley was right here. Um,
- it was at that point where I heard a loud bang and uh I
- flinched when I heard the bang because it was very loud and
- 19 Lieutenant Downing opens the door this way and Officer
- 20 Riley and I both said we've got to get down there and clear
- the cellar, obviously, for safety reasons and to see if
- 22 anyone else was down there. I went down the stairs with
- Officer Riley and was followed by Sergeant Stuart and um

- Officer Casey. We cleared the cellar. There was a lot of
- 2 -- I don't know if you've been down in the cellar -- but
- 3 there was a lot of junk.
- 4 FOSTER: [Inaudible; overlapping dialogue]
- 5 SEBASTIAN: There was a lot of junk around there and there
- 6 was a lot of nooks and crannies. So I was down there for
- approximately three minutes, two to three minutes. When I
- 8 came back up I knew something had happened in this area
- 9 right here. I didn't see anything happen.
- 10 FOSTER: Why don't you just --
- 11 SEBASTIAN: It's actually, it's not in the picture, but it
- would be -- if this picture were bigger -- it would be
- right around this area right here. This kitchen squared
- out into a little hallway area.
- 15 FOSTER: To a little hallway area.
- 16 SEBASTIAN: That also, I think, had another blanket hanging...
- 17 I'm not sure. I thought I may have seen it. It was dark
- in there, though. It was very dark. So when I came up the
- 19 stairs, I peeled this way and walked out and was met by
- Deputy Chief Davis and he asked, "What happened?" I said,
- "I really don't know what happened." I didn't -- I did. I
- think before I went down they called for the medics because
- they were calling for a medic and I was the closest one

here to the yellow sign and the ambulance had pulled right up to the front. So when I came out, the medics were coming in with the stretcher. Everything is -- it just seemed like everything was in the way, like the guys that were wearing those SWAT outfits, it's difficult to move So they were having a little bit of trouble getting everything, all their equipment in. When I peeled back out, um, I was probably outside for a minute and the medics had the victim, I guess, come through the door and they were having a lot of problems with him because he was so large and he wasn't -- they were having a hard time just balancing him on the stretcher. So I walked over to the ambulance and they asked for a little bit of help. I had all my gear on, plus my weapons on the side, so I really couldn't help them out, but I um --

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
