NARRATIVE

*****Witness Statement Eileen Lowe*****

On Tuesday February 16, 2022 at approximately 12:52PM, I spoke with Eileen Lowe regarding the incident that occurred on Saturday February 12, 2022. Lowe made herself known at the scene that she had witnessed some of the incident that took place.

The following is a synopsis of the statements made by Eileen Lowe when I spoke with her.

I was out for a walk with my husband David and daughter Kristina Cunningham. We walked down North Hancock St towards the rotary on Hancock St, my husband and daughter were ahead of me during our walk. As I approached the rotary I heard raised voices. I walked towards a driveway and heard loud voices coming from the back of the driveway and could see 2 heads. There was a man at the end of the driveway wearing darkish clothing and was about 5' 10". My daughter then called to me informing me that her and my husband had crossed the street, I then crossed the street to head towards Diamond. As I was crossing the street I heard running footsteps and voices yelling " Drop the gun" three times.

I then turned to look at the round about, and saw a man running across the round about, I then saw a police officer with his back to me holding a long gun and had it up to his shoulder. I heard the police officer shout "Drop the gun," then heard 2 to 3 shots, and the man that was running fell face down, then rolled onto his left side. I then told my husband and daughter to get behind a tree, which we did. The officers appeared to be 15 feet possibly closer to the man before hearing the shots.

My daughter, husband and I then left and walked down the access road to Diamond, and then we heard 3 or 4 more rapid shots, and very clear commands were "Drop the gun, drop the gun" coming from the Officers.
