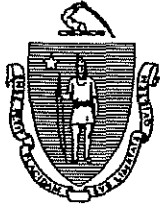

SUBJECT: INTERVIEW OF [REDACTED]

1. On July 2, 2013, I, along with other State Police Officers conducted a canvas of the area around 13 Metropolitan Avenue in Ashland. During this canvas, I had occasion to speak to a subject who provided the following identification information:

2. [REDACTED] began by stating that he had been at his nearby residence, which was located near the end of Metropolitan Avenue, when he heard a lot of sirens. He exited his home and walked towards Metropolitan Avenue. Once he got closer to the end of the street, he saw a number of cruisers and police officers in front of the white house on Metropolitan Ave where he knows "a guy named Andy lives." He observed approximately "6 or so" police officers with their guns drawn outside the residence. Some of the officers had handguns, and some had rifles. For about 15 minutes the officers were outside of the residence until an Ashland Police cruiser marked "K-9" arrived at the address. The canine officer came out of the cruiser with a dog, and [REDACTED] observed him go between the main residence and the garage, and out of his view. Approximately 2 minutes or so later, [REDACTED] heard the "muffled sound of yelling, [and] then heard 2 pops." Because the sound was muffled, [REDACTED] could not hear what was being yelled, nor who was yelling. Right after this, a few officers exited the house, and a cruiser that had been parked outside with a female secured in the back of it pulled away. After the cruiser pulled away, two ambulances arrived.

3. [REDACTED] reported that he had since heard from other unidentified bystanders who had gathered that the resident of the home which knew as "Andy" had been shot inside the home.
