



1 On March 24, 2012, I responded to Malden Police Department to assist in the processing of several motor vehicles involved in the shooting. I was responsible for the processing of a red Honda Civic, Massachusetts registration [REDACTED]. A warrant was obtained for the processing of this motor vehicle. Within the warrant it was stated that the chemical process utilized would "cause irreparable harm or damage to the vehicle."

2 On March 25, 2012, Lieutenant Paul D'Amore, Sergeant David Mahan, Trooper Sidney Chambers and I processed the motor vehicle using appropriate and approved methods and techniques. Several latent impressions were developed. I collected 21 latent impressions.

3 On May 14, 2012, the following latent impressions were determined to have sufficient quality and quantity (SQQ) to conduct further comparisons
