1. On March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2012 at approximately 8:05 P.M., this officer along with Trooper Banks interviewed the above subject at his residence.
2. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that at approximately 5 P.M. he was laying down taking a nap when he heard multiple gun shots. He said he got up and looked out of his window and observed a group of kids looking down a hill. He could not see what they were looking at from his vantage point. He heard police sirens and a commotion. He also said he heard a helicopter.
3. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that at approximately 7:35 P.M. he walked downstairs to see what was going on. As he walked to the first floor, he observed a pair of sneakers sticking out from under the stairwell. He stated that he could not see the person or any of the individual's body parts. He stated he believed the sneakers were black. He stated he was nervous because of what was going on outside of the building. He walked past the person and looked for a police officer. As he entered the lobby, he saw a police officer and advised him of what he had seen in the staircase.
