1. On March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2012 at approximately 7:30 P.M, the above name subject was interviewed at her apartment regarding an attempted car jacking. Also present was her boyfriend:

2. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that she left work in Boston and arrived in Malden to pick up her baby daughter at approximately 4:45 PM. She placed her baby in her car seat on the rear passenger side of the car. Ms. [REDACTED] continued to her residence. As she turned into the parking lot of her complex from Broadway, she observed three white males running in front of her Honda Accord. She stated that one of the males was possibly wearing a royal blue hat and a white T-shirt. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that this male jumped over a fence towards Broadway. The other two males were behind her and to the left. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that she could see that they were sweating and that they were out of breath.

3. Ms. [REDACTED] parked her car to the left of the entrance to her building. She said that she looked up to see where the men were. As she turned around, the men were right at the driver's window of her vehicle. She stated that she tried to lock the door but she hit the window instead. She stated that there was a skinny white male wearing a black hoodie on the passenger side of the vehicle. He was pointing a gun at her and telling her to get out. She said there was a

big fat bald man at the driver's side of her vehicle. She said he had a black sweater in his hand and it seemed as though he was trying to hand it to her. The skinny guy was yelling at her "I don't want to hurt you; we're in a lot of trouble". Ms. [REDACTED] told both men she just wanted to get her baby from the back seat. She heard one of the men say "damn, there's a baby in the car". Ms. [REDACTED] stated that she exited her vehicle and ran around the back to get her daughter out of the car. As she was attempting to get her daughter out of the car seat, she could feel the car moving. She was able to remove her daughter from her car seat and cradled her in her arms. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that she began to walk backwards towards her building. At this time she saw a police officer wearing a red shirt and a bullet-proof vest approaching them in the parking lot. She stated that he had his gun out. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that the big fat guy was attempting to drive the car and the skinny white male was in the front passenger seat. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that they were having trouble operating the car. She believed that the driver did not know how to use a stick shift. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that the two men got out of the car. She stated that the skinny guy ran towards the fence, she was not sure where the fat male ran. She heard the police officer say "stop, put the gun down", "Don't even think about it". Ms. [REDACTED] stated that she continued to walk backwards towards the grass in front of her building. As she got on the grass, she heard shots. She stated that with her daughter in her arms, she ducked behind a car. She stated that she did not see who shot first and does not recall how many shots were fired. She stated that there were multiple shots. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that she was able to run into her building and to her apartment.

4. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he was in the kitchen of his apartment awaiting the arrival of his girlfriend Ms. [REDACTED]. While he was in the kitchen, he heard several gun shots. He said he ran to the window in his living room. He saw a white male against the fence next to Broadway. There was a woman that was approximately 5-7 feet away from him. He said that there was a police officer in red shirt approximately 10-15 feet away from the white male. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that they were shooting at each other. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he was surprised that they did not shoot each other because they were very close to each other. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that at first the police officer was in the open while he was shooting. He began to back up near the parked cars by the fence. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that at some point the shooting stopped. He said the white male jumped over the fence.

At this time Mr. [REDACTED] looked down into the parking lot and observed his Honda Accord. He realized that his girlfriend and daughter were in the lot. He stated that he ran downstairs to locate them. He did not see them and ran back upstairs to his apartment where he located his girlfriend frightened in a bedroom.
