1. On Saturday March 24, 2012 at approximately 2 P.M., the above named subject was interviewed at her apartment.
2. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that on Friday March 23rd at approximately 5 P.M., she was picked up by a Malden Taxi cab in front of her building. She stated that she going to the Seaport District to celebrate her birthday. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that she asked the cab driver to stop at a market across the street so that she could use the ATM. She said the driver stopped at the store and went in with her. She stated that he bought a scratch ticket. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that as they sat in the cab, the driver scratched the ticket and said that he had won his \$2 dollars back. As she sat in the rear of the cab, she heard the driver say "Oh shoot, Oh shoot" as he looked across the street. Ms. [REDACTED] turned attention to the parking lot across the street and saw a woman get out of a car. She next observed this woman to take a baby out of the back seat of the car. Ms. [REDACTED] said she saw a male near the car with the woman and baby. She described the male as wearing dark clothing and a dark hoodie with the hood over his head. She said this individual had a shiny gun in his hand. She next observed a man with a red shirt in the parking lot to the left of the car. She believed this man was a police officer. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that the man wearing the hoodie was in the parking lot to the left of the car. She could not hear what was being said. Her attention was drawn to an empty lot to the left of the building. She said she believed she saw a police officer with a guy on the ground. She next heard one gunshot and then a series of 5 (five) or (six) gunshots. Ms. [REDACTED] said she looked back into the parking lot and saw the male with the hoodie jump over the fence. She said that he still had the gun in his hand



as he ran across the street. She told the cab driver to move but traffic was moving in both directions in front of them and they couldn't pull out.

4. Ms. [REDACTED] said the man in the hoodie ran up to the cab and told the driver, "let me get this cab". She said the driver told him to "get the hell out of here". She said the guy ran towards the paint store and that's the last she saw of him. Ms. [REDACTED] said the driver told her "I don't think he has anymore rounds, that was a revolver".
