

SUBJECT: AUTOPSY OF WILLIAM EKASALA (DOB 7/22/76)

1. On Saturday March 24, 2012 this officer responded to the Medical Examiner's Office in Boston to attend the autopsy of William Ekasala. Dr Niels conducted the autopsy. Trooper Cote of ballistics was present along with Trooper Quigley of Crime Scene Services. Ekasala had a projectile in his left wrist and another in his brain. Dr. Niels determined the cause of death to be gun shot wounds to the head with injury to skull and brain, and the manner to be homicide.
