1. On 07-03-13, this officer was requested to contact [REDACTED], regarding information on the fatal Ashland Police Shooting that occurred on 07-02-2013.

2. On 07-10-13, this officer spoke with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that back in March of 2013 he met Andrew Stigliano through his friend [REDACTED] an employee at the Family Dollar store in Ashland.

Stigliano stated to [REDACTED], he had his grandfathers, Savage Arms, .410 gauge, over/under shotgun, he was interested in selling. At the time, the weapon was in possession of the Ashland Police Department, as it had been seized in an investigation.

[REDACTED] stated he made arrangements to purchase it from Stigliano, and offered to take possession of this weapon when the proceedings were over and it was returned. [REDACTED] stated he called a sergeant at Ashland Police Department a couple of times, but never got a response back.

3. [REDACTED] wanted to pass the information along, in case this was the same shotgun that was present at the fatal shooting.
