1. On Saturday March 24th, 2012 the above subject was interviewed at his residence regarding a police related shooting that had occurred on the previous day.
2. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that on Friday March 23rd at approximately 5 P.M., he was in his bedroom. He heard a "pop" that he thought was a gun shot. His son was in another bedroom and yelled out, "Dad, they're shooting out there". Mr. [REDACTED] stated he looked out of his living room window and saw who he believed to be a black male firing a gun. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that the subject was standing on the sidewalk near Broadway in between two trees. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that weapon the individual was firing was definitely an automatic because he could see the slide moving back and forth when the gun was fired. He stated that the male subject was wearing jeans and a shirt and he had on a bullet-proof vest. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that the subject fired multiple shots. Mr. [REDACTED] believed that the individual emptied his weapon of ammunition. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that the individual that was firing the gun jumped into a dark colored sedan on Broadway and drove away. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he observed a bald guy run into the building. He believed this individual was firing a weapon also.
