1. On February 12, 2022, at approximately 1350 hours I was dispatched to Lexington to assist in the above investigation. Upon arrival I met with Sergeant Tony Delucia and case officer, Trooper Christopher Murgo, of the MSP Middlesex County Detective Unit, who requested that the scene be documented. Lieutenant Colleen Tanguay and Sergeant Lance Mello of the MSP Crime Scene Services Section also responded to the scene to assist. I took digital photographs and created a sketch of the scene and Lt. Colleen Tanguay took digital video of the scene. Sgt Lance Mello responded to Lahey Clinic in Burlington to document the suspect.
2. I collected a knife (Placard 17; later itemized as Item 3-1) and transported it back to the Maynard Crime Lab for processing. Please refer to the Evidence Recovery Log for other items of evidence located at the scene.
3. The following item was documented, processed and analyzed for friction ridge impressions. The following is a conclusion of my results:

3-1 Qty: 1	Knife - inside a plastic ziplock bag (ziplock bag not evidence)- Placard 17  After processing, no friction ridge impressions of value were observed.
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4. All items were repackaged and sent forward for additional testing within the Crime Laboratory. Copies of the photographs were sent to the appropriate personnel. I respectfully request this case be closed pending the submission of additional evidence.
