SUBJECT: INTERVIEW OF [REDACTED]

1. On March 23, 2012 at approximately 1914hrs, Det. Jason Froio and I were present at apartment #2135 at the Cliffside Commons and conducted an interview of:

[REDACTED] advised us that he lives in the apartment with his fiancé; however, she was not home on this date. Froio stated that at approximately 1700hrs, he was in his apartment playing X-Box games. He heard commotion coming from the parking lot outside. Specifically, he heard someone yelling "Hey, Hey...Come Here". He looked out the window and saw a man wearing a brownish and olive green hooded sweatshirt. He described this man as being tall. [REDACTED] could provide no other description. This man was standing by the passenger window of a silver sedan which was parked northbound in the parking lot. He observed a female driving the car and she began to pull away. He further observed a 2nd male near the rear quarter panel of the driver's side. This man was shorter, heavy set, and wore a white shirt. He was light skinned. As the car pulled away he observed both men run after the car. The taller male dropped something on the ground but quickly picked it up and chased after the car. [REDACTED] assumed it was a domestic incident and went back to playing video games.

2. [REDACTED] stated that after a short period of time (he estimated no longer than 10 minutes) he saw police cruisers driving down Broadway. He observed a police officer in a red shirt and a bullet proof vest running northbound in the parking lot. The officer's gun was drawn and he was yelling, "Freeze Police!" [REDACTED] stated that the men he described earlier ran from the building side of the parking lot to the Broadway side of the parking lot near a green sedan. Both men were on the driver's side of the green sedan. The shorter male with the white shirt came out into the parking lot and then jumped back to take cover behind the green car. The taller male with the hooded sweatshirt then shot a gun towards the officer. [REDACTED] stated that he doesn't know how many times the hooded male shot at the officer but it was more than once. [REDACTED] stated the officer ran closer to the building and returned fire. The man in the hooded sweatshirt ran southbound along the fence and then jumped it. He then crossed Broadway.

3. [REDACTED] stated that he never saw the shorter male with the white shirt again. [REDACTED] stated that more police officers converged into the area. [REDACTED] is not sure if the man in the hooded sweatshirt entered another car or not. [REDACTED] stated that the officers were yelling "Stop" and "Freeze" at a grayish gold sedan that was northbound on Broadway; however, the car wouldn't stop. [REDACTED] observed the officers shooting at the car and the driver fall into the steering wheel.

4. [REDACTED] had no additional information and the interview was concluded.
