SUBJECT: INTERVIEW OF [REDACTED]

1. On March 23, 2012 at approximately 1948hrs, Det. Jason Froio and I were present at [REDACTED] at the Cliffside Commons in Malden and conducted an interview of:

[REDACTED] advised us that approximately 1630-1645hrs on this date she was driving her blue Hyundai Alantra (MA reg# [REDACTED]) in the parking lot of the Cliffside Commons. She pulled into a parking spot facing Broadway and shut off the car. She was about to exit the car when a man opened the door and said "Give me the keys." She described the man as 5 2' or 5 3', scruffy unshaven face and in his early twenties. She further stated that he was wearing a gray sweatshirt which possibly was also red in the front. [REDACTED] initially refused to produce her keys. After the man produced a gun she exited the vehicle. [REDACTED] described the gun as a small silver handgun (possibly with a cylinder). [REDACTED] stepped out of the car with her keys in her hand. The man immediately entered the car. [REDACTED] stated that the man appeared to believe that the keys were still in the car. The man then exited the car just as a police officer (wearing jeans and a red shirt) approached. The officer yelled to [REDACTED] to get down and take cover. [REDACTED] ducked down behind the car that was next to hers. She then observed the man in the hooded sweatshirt fire three shots at the officer and the officer return fire. The man in the hooded sweatshirt then ran southbound along the fence. [REDACTED] ran inside the building and made no further observations.
