SUBJECT: INTERVIEW OF [REDACTED], RE; MALDEN POLICE SHOOTING

1. On Friday March 23rd, 2012 at approximately 2353 hours during the course of the investigation into the Malden police shooting at 500 Broadway I was approached by an individual who identified himself to me as;

500 Broadway [REDACTED], Malden, MA

[REDACTED] stated he was in his apartment, which is on the first floor, when he heard what he believed to be gunshots outside his apartment. [REDACTED]'s first floor apartment is in the front of 500 Broadway facing Broadway. [REDACTED] stated when he looked out his front window he observed somebody get into a car and then observed what he believed to be three plainclothes police officers run up to the car. He observed the car move forward but did not see anything more after that. At this point [REDACTED] decided to get his camera and took pictures of the scene on Broadway of the suspect car and police officers around it. [REDACTED] could not be more specific on descriptions of clothing or vehicles.

2. Fowle offered to provide me a copy on disk of the pictures he took that day. I took possession of the disc, documented it and included it in the case file.
