SUBJECT: INTERVIEW OF [REDACTED], RE; MALDEN POLICE SHOOTING

1. On Friday March 24th, 2012 at approximately 1300 hours during the course of the investigation into the Malden police shooting at 500 Broadway I and Malden Police Detectives Mitch Montina and Jason Froio met and spoke with;

[REDACTED] lives on the first floor apartment which is on the right corner of the main entrance of 500 Broadway opposite the main lobby. [REDACTED] resides there with his wife, [REDACTED], DOB [REDACTED] 48.

2. [REDACTED] stated about 1700 hours on Friday, March 23rd he heard a crash outside and went to the window with his wife to see what it was. In the handicap parking space outside his window [REDACTED] observed a small red car parked and three males walking past his window towards the Broadway side. He described the three males as one being a short, about 5'9" white male wearing a black sweatshirt with the hood pulled up, the other a clean-shaven white male with a bald head and a dark-skinned black male, he was unsure of his dress. [REDACTED] stated he recognized the short white male from the television news reports of his arrest.

3. [REDACTED] stated he heard the dark-skinned black male say "where's the other car?" to the other two as he was walking past their window. After the three disappeared from his sight [REDACTED] stated two or three minutes passed when he heard gunshots from the front of the building near Broadway. He then observed the short, white male walking fast back towards the lobby and his apartment window. At this time [REDACTED] and his wife [REDACTED] were leaning



outside their window and the short, white male said to them as he walked past “They’re shooting back there!”

4. After the short, white male walked past, [REDACTED] stated he and his wife went to thier bedroom which overlooks the front parking lot and looked towards Broadway. He stated he “saw shots into the gray car in the street”. He further stated he observed the body in the driver’s seat bouncing back and forth inside the car. [REDACTED] stated he then saw the car move forward and stop. [REDACTED] stated he didn’t see any other people involved after this.
