SUBJECT: MALDEN POLICE SHOOTING-CELL PHONE VIDEO

1. On Friday, March 23rd, 2012, I was involved in an investigation concerning an armed bank robbery in the Town of Saugus, and subsequent police shooting in the City of Malden. At approximately 1830hrs, I arrived on scene, at the address of 500 Broadway Street in Malden. The building is a large five story housing complex facing Route 99. As I arrived on scene, a man approached me and identified himself as [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] explained he is a resident of the complex ([REDACTED]) and had information concerning the shooting. [REDACTED] explained his brother in law, identified as [REDACTED], was home in apartment [REDACTED], when he heard commotion down in the parking lot. [REDACTED] states [REDACTED] grabbed his cell phone and began to audio and video record the events that followed, capturing the police shooting on tape.

2. I then asked if he had viewed the video himself and he said he had. I asked [REDACTED] for his cellular telephone number and told him I would call him shortly to meet with [REDACTED]. He agreed and left me with his number, [REDACTED]. A short time later I called [REDACTED] and told him I would like to speak to [REDACTED] concerning the cell phone video. He stated [REDACTED] was home and was expecting my visit.
