

INTERVIEW OF ANTHONY PERROTTI

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1 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** James Connolly, from the
2 Massachusetts State Police. I'm sorry we're meeting under the
3 circumstances.

4 **LT. BULMAN:** Paul Bulman, from the State Police.

5 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** To be honest with you, I just got
6 here. So I don't know a ton of information and I kind of was
7 hoping that you could fill us in on some of it. What do you
8 know happened today?

9 **MR. PERROTTI:** My brother came home, I was at
10 work. I see him walking, so I walk over to him, to say "Hey,
11 what's up?"

12 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** What time about, was that?

13 **MR. PERROTTI:** Ah, man, maybe, I don't know man.
14 Maybe 12, 1, 2. I really can't remember the exact time, but it
15 was in that area. So I walk over to him, and I said "Hey,
16 what's up?". "Nothing, just getting home." I was like "Oh,
17 okay." So I go in with him - to his house. And he opens the
18 door, I go in - he goes in - I go in behind him.

19 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Where's that? I'm sorry.

20 **MR. PERROTTI:** Where?

21 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Where's the house?

22 **MR. PERROTTI:** At the gas station.

23 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Okay.

1 **MR. PERROTTI:** 1462 Main Street. So, I walk in
2 behind him, and then I walk past him because I could see
3 somebody in his bedroom, which is downstairs, and it was
4 Devin's girlfriend, Kim. And he says "What the fuck are you
5 doing in my bedroom? Why are you touching my stuff?" So I said
6 to Kim, "What are you doing in his bedroom? Just get out. Get
7 out." So then he starts yelling "Get the fuck out of the house!
8 Get out!" And then he goes "Why are you touching my radio? Why
9 is my TV unplugged?" So he grabs the - Al grabs the speaker,
10 smashes it on the ground. It bounced off of me, and I said
11 "Alright, Kim, just leave." I go "He's pissed off you were in
12 his bedroom. So just get out."

13 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Does she live there?

14 **MR. PERROTTI:** She's Devin's girlfriend, so
15 she's kind of living there, I guess? You know what I mean?

16 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** I'm sorry, who's Devin?

17 **MR. PERROTTI:** Devin's the roommate.

18 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** How many people live in the
19 house?

20 **MR. PERROTTI:** Three. Well Alan and Devin
21 originally moved in. Al's living there, and then Devin moved
22 in, as a roommate. And then Devin asked to have his girlfriend
23 stay there.

24 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** So the three of them?

1 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah.

2 **LT. BULMAN:** You know Devin's last name?

3 **MR. PERROTTI:** McDonald.

4 **LT. BULMAN:** Approximate age?

5 **MR. PERROTTI:** Maybe the same age as Al, 41?

6 **LT. BULMAN:** White female?

7 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah.

8 **LT. BULMAN:** No fixed abode? Or no residence?

9 **MR. PERROTTI:** No.

10 **LT. BULMAN:** No home address or anything?

11 **MR. PERROTTI:** No, I don't think.

12 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Did he smash his own speaker?

13 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah. "You're not going to use my

14 stuff". Smashes it. "Do you think you can be in my room when

15 I'm not here?" He just kept yelling and yelling. And actually

16 she went and sat - I'm sorry - she sat on the bottom of the

17 steps first, and then Devin came down and Al started yelling at

18 him and then they went upstairs and started yelling at each

19 other, arguing and then I heard like a shuffle, and then Al

20 came down, Devin came down, and I said "Guys, just leave.

21 Listen, this isn't going to go any better. Everybody's going to

22 keep arguing." So, Devin and Kim left.

23 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** About what time did they leave?

1 **MR. PERROTTI:** Like I said, it happened between
2 12 and 2, so -

3 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** So how long about was that
4 argument?

5 **MR. PERROTTI:** 10 minutes.

6 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** So now it's just you and your
7 brother at the house?

8 **MR. PERROTTI:** I said, "They're gone, just
9 fucking chill out." And he goes "They better not fucking come
10 back in my house. They shouldn't be in my bedroom." And I said
11 "Whatever" I said "I'm leaving" and I left.

12 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Did you ever come back?

13 **MR. PERROTTI:** No.

14 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** So then how did you end up here?

15 **MR. PERROTTI:** I work there.

16 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Oh, okay.

17 **MR. PERROTTI:** I work next door.

18 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** You were working tonight?

19 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah. Today.

20 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** So when's the next time you saw
21 your brother?

22 **MR. PERROTTI:** I saw him through the window, in
23 the apartment. When the officers showed up there. The officers
24 showed up, it was probably like four officers, and they knocked

1 on the door, they asked me if he was there, and i said I don't
2 know. I didn't know if he left, because I went back into the
3 shop to work. So they said, "Do you have a key?" and I said
4 "Yeah", so we grabbed the key. Key wouldn't open the door
5 because the dead-bolt was locked. So, they kept at it for a
6 while, yelling at him through the door, finally he responded to
7 them, and they kept going back and forth. I called Al multiple
8 times, trying to say "Hey, listen, just come out" he goes "I'm
9 not coming out! They're going to beat me up!" Al - he got hurt
10 by a couple officers, broke his - fractured his eye socket
11 before, so he's petrified. So I said "Listen, they're not going
12 to do anything. Just come out. Just come out please." He's like
13 "No, I'm not coming out they're going to cuff me! And they're
14 going to beat me up" blah, blah, blah. So I said "Alright, so
15 that's not working". More officers showed up. Kept yelling
16 through the door. Weren't getting anywhere. So now you got
17 probably seven officers on the property, ambulance - not
18 ambulance - fire trucks, fire department. I called Al again, I
19 said "Can you get on the phone?" He wouldn't get on the phone.
20 I go "Can you come to a window?" He comes to a window, and
21 starts arguing with Officer Wilson and he's like "I'm not
22 letting you in. I'm not letting you in. You're the officer that
23 arrested me. I beat your case." You know, "You're not coming in
24 here". So, he slammed the window- I'm trying to remember

1 everything for you guys. Slammed the window, walked away. And
2 I'll tell you everything exactly like it was. Officer Wilson
3 came up to me, and said "Can you go in there? If we go in there
4 he's going to end up with a broken nose or a broken jaw."

5 **MR. PERROTTI:** I said, "Why are you telling me
6 this?". "Because that's what's gonna happen. You control him,
7 or we're gonna control him." he said.

8 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Do you know him?

9 **MR. PERROTTI:** Who?

10 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Officer Wilson.

11 **MR. PERROTTI:** Negative.

12 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** How did you know his name?

13 **MR. PERROTTI:** I saw his badge. His nametag. So,
14 I just said "Well", I kind of understood what he meant, you
15 know, like, because if you have to control somebody, but it's a
16 little much. But I understand what he was saying. So I said
17 "Alright, let me try to go in there." So at that point, I go -
18 oh, no, at point, I'm looking over and I see Al walk in the
19 office, and yelling at my boss, saying something.

20 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** How did he get in the office?

21 **MR. PERROTTI:** The door goes to the office.

22 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** So the inside of the apartment
23 can go -

24 **MR. PERROTTI:** Right, yeah.

1 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** To the inside of the gas station?

2 **MR. PERROTTI:** It's connected. So, I saw him run
3 out and yell something, and then run back in. So after that, I
4 decided to go -

5 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** I'm sorry, who was that, that he
6 was talking to?

7 **MR. PERROTTI:** My boss, Joe.

8 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Joe.

9 **MR. PERROTTI:** Talal.

10 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Talal.

11 **MR. PERROTTI:** Joe.

12 **LT. BULMAN:** Is that the owner of the gas
13 station?

14 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yes.

15 **LT. BULMAN:** And is he the landlord also?

16 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yes. So, I'm like let me go in
17 there, bang on the door, because I said "Let me see if I can
18 get inside, and I can walk him outside, without any issues."
19 So, I went in, I banged on the door, he didn't respond. I
20 called his phone, I could hear it ringing. No answer. So, I
21 decided, let me try the door, and the door opened. So I walk
22 in, I yell, I don't see him, I don't hear him, nothing. So I
23 run back out and I said "Listen, this side's open. I don't hear
24 him, he's not in there, his phone's ringing. And that's when

1 they come inside and nobody was in there. I guess they said he
2 went out the back window. And they come outside - no, I come
3 outside - officers were still in - those three officers were
4 still inside, there were some still at the door - because - so
5 you've got probably two officers standing at the door from what
6 I remember, three by this side. I go outside, from the office,
7 after the officers go "Can you just wait out here?" and I said
8 "Yeah, sure", so I go outside, and that's when I heard the
9 gunshots. And I ran over to the right side of the building, and
10 I was the first one there, and I see the door open to the
11 Hummer. I see the officer kneeling down, my brother hunched
12 over, bleeding.

13 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Where was he?

14 **MR. PERROTTI:** Where was who?

15 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Al.

16 **MR. PERROTTI:** On the ground. On his knees,
17 hunched over, underneath the door, like the door was open. So
18 I'm assuming he came out of the car and -

19 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Which door?

20 **MR. PERROTTI:** The passenger door. And he was
21 facing the front of the car, hunched over.

22 **DET. FITZGERALD:** Anthony, when you say, you saw
23 him to the right of the building, if you're looking at the gas
24 station -

1 **MR. PERROTTI:** It's on the left.

2 **DET. FITZGERALD:** On the left hand side, okay.

3 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Who's Hummer is it?

4 **MR. PERROTTI:** Customer's.

5 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Why would he be going into a
6 customer's car? Maybe just to hide?

7 **MR. PERROTTI:** Hiding, that's what I assumed.
8 Absolutely. He was petrified. After his last incident. Police
9 did - I mean he had bruises, broken eye socket, so -

10 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Where was that?

11 **MR. PERROTTI:** That was Winchester, I think.
12 Winchester.

13 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Do you know when it was?

14 **MR. PERROTTI:** Maybe a few months - yeah, no,
15 four months ago, five months ago?

16 **LT. BULMAN:** Was it Winchester Police?

17 **MR. PERROTTI:** I believe so.

18 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Do you know who the officer was?

19 **MR. PERROTTI:** I didn't get it. I kept asking
20 his name, he wouldn't give it to me.

21 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** That wasn't Officer Wilson?

22 **MR. PERROTTI:** No. It was not.

23 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** How many officers were on that
24 side of the -

1 **MR. PERROTTI:** Only the single officer was
2 hunched over Al, kneeling down next to him, at the time. And
3 then when I ran back to let- I was yelling, I said "They shot
4 him. They shot him." And that's when the other officers ran
5 over. Then they told me get out - go over there.

6 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Did that officer have his gun
7 out?

8 **MR. PERROTTI:** Couldn't tell if he had his gun
9 out.

10 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Does Al have a gun?

11 **MR. PERROTTI:** No.

12 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Did he have any weapons?

13 **MR. PERROTTI:** No.

14 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Did you ever see him with
15 anything -

16 **MR. PERROTTI:** He had a piece of wood inside the
17 apartment, but Officer Wilson had asked me after everything had
18 happened, he said "Can you tell me what he was holding? Or what
19 you think he was holding?" and I said "Yeah", and he goes - he
20 brought me into the apartment, and I said "It was one of those
21 four legs", because there was a table broken in there.

22 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Yeah.

1 **MR. PERROTTI:** So it was one of those four legs,
2 and all four legs were still there. The one he was holding was
3 right next to the window, still there.

4 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Was that customer, the Hummer -
5 was -

6 **MR. PERROTTI:** No.

7 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** That person there -

8 **MR. PERROTTI:** No.

9 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Or they dropped it off?

10 **MR. PERROTTI:** No. The car's been here. We've
11 been doing some big work to it.

12 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Did you see anybody else on that
13 side of the building?

14 **MR. PERROTTI:** After the shooting?

15 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Before or after, at any point.

16 **MR. PERROTTI:** No, as soon as I heard the
17 shooting - the two gunshots, I ran over that side, and that's
18 all I saw - I saw exactly what I said. Al hunched over, on the
19 ground, on his knees, and the officer right behind him. I
20 couldn't tell what he was doing, he was - it just looked like -
21 I don't know, I couldn't tell. All I know is I saw blood all
22 around Al.

23 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Where were you when you heard the
24 gunshot?

1 **MR. PERROTTI:** I was right at the gas pumps.
2 Right near the garage door. Right underneath the lean-to part
3 of it.

4 **DET. FITGERALD:** The front guest door that goes
5 into the office?

6 **MR. PERROTTI:** I was closer to the garage door.
7 It's probably on video, so you'll see it.

8 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Are there any videos on that side
9 of the -

10 **MR. PERROTTI:** No. We never put one. We
11 should've.

12 **LT. BULMAN:** How well lit is that area?

13 **MR. PERROTTI:** It was light out.

14 **LT. BULMAN:** It was still light out?

15 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah. Oh, yeah. There was still
16 plenty of light.

17 **LT. BULMAN:** So what time did this happen?

18 **MR. PERROTTI:** I think I said, it was light out,
19 so - that's where I can't remember if it was 12, 1, 2, so,
20 maybe 3? I don't know. I don't know. You guys would know better
21 what time the gunshots went through the recording - you know,
22 right - did they tell you that?

23 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** I wasn't kidding, I legitimately
24 just got here, I'm not sure.

1 **MR. PERROTTI:** Oh, no, no, no. I know. But I
2 don't know times, because it was just so - it happened so
3 quick. What time did Al come to the house, I'm trying to
4 remember. Might've been 1 o'clock. The shots probably went out
5 at 3. So, maybe it was an hour span that the officers were at
6 the house? Trying to, you know, talk to him.

7 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** So when you had left earlier,
8 when you said that Devin and Kim leave, and then you left Al by
9 himself in the apartment -

10 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah.

11 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** You just went over to the gas
12 station, you didn't leave the property?

13 **MR. PERROTTI:** No, I was at work.

14 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Yup.

15 **MR. PERROTTI:** Did you stay on that side of the
16 building any longer after that?

17 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** After?

18 **MR. PERROTTI:** After you -

19 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** The shooting?

20 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah.

21 No, they told me "Go over there". I stood there for
22 maybe a minute.

23 (PAUSE)

24 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Did Al say anything?

1 **MR. PERROTTI:** As far as?

2 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Did he see you when you came
3 around the building?

4 **MR. PERROTTI:** He was - he couldn't move. He was
5 hunched over. He wasn't moving.

6 (PAUSE)

7 **LT. BULMAN:** Had there been problems at this
8 apartment, with the roommate?

9 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Yeah. They get into stupid
10 arguments, you know, every once in a while. They both drink.

11 **LT. BULMAN:** Do you know what occurred last night?

12 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** No, I don't know (indiscernible).

13 **LT. BULMAN:** Did you hear anything go on?

14 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** I heard something happened.

15 **LT. BULMAN:** What did you hear had happened last
16 night?

17 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Devin said that Al came in, broke
18 the table and chairs. Al says, Al walked in the house, says the
19 table and chairs were broken, and he started giving Devin shit,
20 "Why is all this shit broken?" So, in all honesty, I don't know
21 who is telling the truth.

22 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Do you know who called the
23 police?

24 **MR. PERROTTI:** I don't.

1 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Do you think it was Devin and
2 Kim?

3 **MR. PERROTTI:** I'm assuming.

4 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Is there possibly any neighbors
5 that are close enough-

6 **MR. PERROTTI:** No. No. There wasn't any kind of
7 altercation that would have people come over, or call the
8 police, it wasn't like something that would make people call,
9 you know.

10 (PAUSE)

11 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** What did Al say about the chair
12 and table - the broken chairs and table?

13 **MR. PERROTTI:** He said -

14 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Were they already broken?

15 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah. He said he walked in, and
16 the table and chairs were broken and he screamed at Devin like
17 "Why the fuck are you guys breaking everything in the house?"
18 Because Devin would put holes in the walls, they would break
19 things all the time. Him and his girlfriend always fight.

20 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Oh, I'm sorry. So I
21 misunderstood. Al was mad at Devin for breaking the tables and
22 chairs?

23 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah. Al questioned Devin - this
24 is what Al told me. Like I said, they both said that he said

1 she said. So Al broke it - that's what Devin said, and Al's
2 saying Devin broke it, because it was broken when he came in
3 the house. So, like I said, I wasn't there, I don't know what
4 happened. They're both telling me one thing - and in all
5 honesty, I just got a procedure yesterday, I got both of them
6 telling me one story to another, I said "Guys, please. Grow the
7 fuck up and just get over it."

8 **LT. BULMAN:** Okay, when you say procedure, are you
9 like medicated right now?

10 **MR. PERROTTI:** No, I had a procedure for -
11 endoscopy yesterday.

12 **LT. BULMAN:** Oh, okay. Okay. Alright. Just want to
13 make sure -

14 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah. I know.

15 **LT. BULMAN:** You weren't -

16 **MR. PERROTTI:** Under the influence.

17 **LT. BULMAN:** Right.

18 **MR. PERROTTI:** I understand.

19 **LT. BULMAN:** So can I walk you back to when you
20 heard the shots fired.

21 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yes.

22 **LT. BULMAN:** So, bear in mind, I have yet to go to
23 the scene.

24 **MR. PERROTTI:** I understand.

1 **LT. BULMAN:** I have never been -

2 **MR. PERROTTI:** I understand.

3 **LT. BULMAN:** To the gas station.

4 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yup.

5 **LT. BULMAN:** If you could just flush a few things -

6 few details out for me?

7 **MR. PERROTTI:** Sure.

8 **LT. BULMAN:** Where you were standing -

9 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yes.

10 **LT. BULMAN:** When you heard the gunshots, would you

11 - is there a lot of road noise near, would it be possible for

12 someone to be having a conversation with your brother and you

13 not hear it from that position?

14 **MR. PERROTTI:** It's tough to say. It's possible,

15 but it's - I couldn't say for sure.

16 **LT. BULMAN:** Do you remember hearing anyone - any

17 conversation -

18 **MR. PERROTTI:** No (indiscernible).

19 **LT. BULMAN:** Crying?

20 **MR. PERROTTI:** Never. No.

21 **LT. BULMAN:** No. So you were standing at the pumps-

22 **MR. PERROTTI:** And I heard, pop, pop.

23 **LT. BULMAN:** Okay. Now was there road noise at the

24 time?

1 **MR. PERROTTI:** No, it was very clear. It was
2 pretty pronounced.

3 **LT. BULMAN:** So there was no traffic in front of
4 the gas station-

5 **MR. PERROTTI:** No, it was pretty quiet.

6 **LT. BULMAN:** Okay.

7 **MR. PERROTTI:** I believe.

8 **LT. BULMAN:** Were there cars at the gas station,
9 gassing up?

10 **MR. PERROTTI:** Actually, no, because, I was
11 standing right in the lane of the cars.

12 **LT. BULMAN:** So it was just like a one - two pump
13 operation, or is it more?

14 **MR. PERROTTI:** No, we have four pumps, but one
15 guy pumps- Saturday's another busy day.

16 **LT. BULMAN:** Okay. Alright.

17 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Was anybody else working with
18 you, besides Joe?

19 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah, they have everybody here.
20 You want their names?

21 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Sure.

22 **MR. PERROTTI:** Michael Rendlli (phonetic) -
23 Rendele (phonetic) - Rendell (phonetic).

24 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** And what's his -

1 **MR. PERROTTI:** He's a gas - he works for the gas
2 pumps. Gasses for us. And then Orlando Ortiz, he's a mechanic.

3 **LT. BULMAN:** Was he in the garage?

4 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yes. Actually, that I don't know.
5 No, actually, I think he was at his car, you've got to ask him
6 that.

7 **LT. BULMAN:** Okay. How about Mike Rendell, was he
8 at the gas pump?

9 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yes.

10 **LT. BULMAN:** At the time?

11 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yes.

12 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Were there any customers there?

13 **MR. PERROTTI:** I don't believe so. There was one
14 customer that was just leaving - they didn't let him leave.
15 There was one car, actually. He was driving a Ford. You'll see
16 that on the camera probably.

17 **LT. BULMAN:** Okay.

18 **MR. PERROTTI:** So they said "What happened?" and
19 I said "There was a shooting".

20 **LT. BULMAN:** And he was in a Ford?

21 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah.

22 **LT. BULMAN:** And he was at the pumps?

23 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yes.

1 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yes.

2 **LT. BULMAN:** Or a call back number?

3 **MR. PERROTTI:** ██████████.

4 **LT. BULMAN:** Can you think of anything else to ask?

5 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** No.

6 **LT. BULMAN:** Have any questions for us?

7 **MR. PERROTTI:** Just want to know what's going

8 on.

9 **LT. BULMAN:** Do you know what's going on?

10 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah, I do.

11 **LT. BULMAN:** You know about your brother's status?

12 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah.

13 **LT. BULMAN:** Who told you that?

14 **MR. PERROTTI:** News on the phone.

15 **LT. BULMAN:** The news on the phone. Okay.

16 **DET. FITZGERALD:** Did you speak to your mother,

17 Anthony? No?

18 **MR. PERROTTI:** No.

19 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Do you want us to do that for

20 you, or do you want to -

21 **MR. PERROTTI:** She's at the hospital, so I don't

22 know - she's with my cousin.

23 **DET. FITZGERALD:** We're sorry for your loss.

1 **LT. BULMAN:** Very sorry for your loss. We were
2 hopeful that you didn't find out that way, and we wanted to
3 tell you.

4 **MR. PERROTTI:** I know. I know.

5 **LT. BULMAN:** That's why we wanted to ask for your
6 phone.

7 **MR. PERROTTI:** No, I understand. I knew. People
8 were texting me anyways.

9 **LT. BULMAN:** Right. Yeah.

10 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Do you need anything?

11 **MR. PERROTTI:** No.

12 **LT. BULMAN:** Do you feel safe to get home?

13 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah.

14 **LT. BULMAN:** Want a ride?

15 **MR. PERROTTI:** No, I've got somebody to drive
16 me. Just got to call them.

17 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** If you don't, I'm sure we can
18 make arrangements.

19 **MR. PERROTTI:** No, I've got somebody. Fuck.

20 **DET. FITZGERALD:** Anthony, do you need anything
21 back at the shop, bud?

22 **MR. PERROTTI:** I don't know.

23 **DET. FITZGERALD:** Is your wallet there or anything?

24 **MR. PERROTTI:** Why, I can't go there?

1 **DET. FITZGERALD:** No, it's still technically a
2 crime scene.

3 **MR. PERROTTI:** I think I've got somebody to come
4 here.

5 **DET. FITZGERALD:** Okay.

6 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** Alright, well unless you need
7 anything from us, then we'll let you get to your family
8 business.

9 **DET. FITZGERALD:** Let me give you my card. If you
10 have any questions or need anything I can give you -

11 **MR. PERROTTI:** Thanks.

12 **DET. FITZGERALD:** Number's on the bottom there,
13 right there.

14 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah.

15 **DET. FITZGERALD:** If we have to reach out to you,
16 maybe brush up some details, maybe ask you a few more
17 questions-

18 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah.

19 **DET. FITZGERALD:** Is it okay to call you at this
20 number that we have?

21 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yeah, okay.

22 **DET. FITZGERALD:** We'll try to minimize our
23 contact, but there may be an instance where we do have to talk
24 to you. Okay?

1 **MR. PERROTTI:** Yup.

2 **LT. BULMAN:** You have any questions for us?

3 **MR. PERROTTI:** No. No. If I do, can I have your
4 cards?

5 **LT. BULMAN:** Yeah. We'll get you some.

6 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** I have to get (indiscernible).

7 **MR. PERROTTI:** Even a piece of paper is fine.

8 **DET. FITZGERALD:** Can we give you a ride anywhere,
9 or are you going to- we can have someone pick you up here, or
10 we can -

11 **MR. PERROTTI:** He's coming now.

12 **DET. FITZGERALD:** Okay. I was going to say, I can
13 offer you a ride somewhere.

14 **MR. PERROTTI:** It's alright. Thank you.

15 (PAUSE)

16 **TPR. CONNOLLY:** I have the worst writing, but
17 that's my cell phone number.

18 **MR. PERROTTI:** Thank you.

19 **DET. FITZGERALD:** Alright Anthony, if you need
20 anything, please reach out to us. Okay?

21 **MR. PERROTTI:** Thank you.

22 (PAUSE)

23 **DET. FITZGERALD:** Want me to walk you downstairs,
24 bud?

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MR. PERROTTI: Are they gone yet?

DET. FITZGERALD: No, you're the first person -

MR. PERROTTI: (Indiscernible) alright.

DET. FITZGERALD: You're the first person that we
wanted to speak to.
