Middlesex CPAC responded and learned that at 1:15 p.m. the Cambridge Police Department received a 911 call for a disturbance, reporting a male was cutting himself with a machete in the rear of 254 Sidney St. Members of the Cambridge Police responded and observed a male cutting himself with a machete. The male took off running from Police and a foot pursuit ensued. 2. Members of the Cambridge Police Police encountered the male in the rear of 59 Chestnut St. A preliminary investigation suggests that commands to "drop the knife" were verbally given to the male, and a less lethal impact munition round was utilized with negative results. 3. The male kept advancing towards the officer armed with the kukri knife. The officer discharged his department issued firearm and struck the male multiple times. 4. First aid was administered at the scene, and the male was transported to Massachusetts General Hospital to be treated for his injuries. The male subcommand to his injuries and was pronounced deceased at the hospital.
