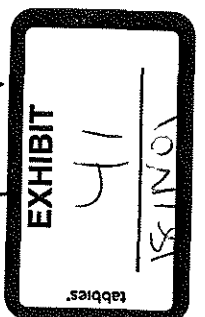

The following is a summary of facts of an incident that led to the application for criminal complaint against Alan Greenough for M.G.L 265-13A Assault and Battery (2 counts).

On February 2, 2018, I was working the "C" shift, 4pm-midnight, in marked patrol cruiser #7 and assigned to patrol Sector 1 in the Town of Reading. At approximately 7:33pm, Dispatch put out a general broadcast for a male who was reporting he was just assaulted by his roommate. All units called off as responding. 1462 Main Street is a gas station with an attached residence with two separate apartments.

All units arrived a few minutes later. We were met by the victim, Devin McDonald, who was sitting on the entry way steps. Devin advised us that his roommate and the suspect, Alan Greenough, had already left the residence prior to our arrival. I asked Devin if he was injured and if he was in need of any medical attention and he told me he was not. Officer Fontes went to the attached gas station and spoke with the attendant, Michael Randall. Mr. Randall told Officer Fontes that he heard two males arguing and then some banging. Officer Savio, Officer Drauschke and I went into the house with Devin. As we entered the apartment I observed smashed furniture all over the kitchen. We searched the apartment for the suspect but did not find him. Officer Savio located Devin's girlfriend, Kimberly Bellino, in an upstairs bedroom and interviewed her. Devin told me the following about had occurred. Alan went out to a friend's wake earlier this evening. Sometime later, he came home intoxicated and out of control. Devin heard Alan having a difficult time entering through the front door. The door sticks from time to time even when unlocked. Alan began kicking the door due to the door not opening. This got Devin's attention. Alan then came in and began kicking a chair in the kitchen. Devin was upstairs and questioned what Alan was doing. Alan then began smashing the chair, breaking it on the floor. He then smashed the table, breaking it into multiple pieces on the floor (See attached photos). Alan then came upstairs and started giving Devin a hard time. Devin said Alan was 'egging him on', saying things about his father who had passed away. Alan then grabbed Devin and began punching at him. They started to wrestle and Alan elbowed Devin in the mouth. Devin then put Alan in a headlock to get him under control. Alan then went downstairs after Kimberly said she was calling the police. Alan then left with an unknown female in an unknown vehicle.

Kimberly told Officer Savio that after smashing the furniture in the kitchen, Alan came upstairs and entered their bedroom. Kimberly was off to the left of the room opposite Devin. Alan then made an effort to go out of his way to grab Kimberly by the arm and push her. Kimberly did not have any injuries and declined a medical evaluation. Kimberly also said that Alan was choking Devin. When Devin was asked if he was choked he declined, saying that they both put each other in headlocks.

While speaking with Devin, I observed a reddish-brown scratch mark and bruise on the left side his neck and his left cheek was red. There was also dried blood on his bottom lip and in his mouth. Again, I asked Devin if he need any medical attention and he refused.

Both Devin and Kimberly were advised of the 209A rights and refused to exercise them at this time. A Domestic Violence High Risk Assessment Worksheet was filled out by Officer Fontes and I.
