Marlborough Police Department NARRATIVE FOR PATROL JAMES OMALLEY

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On April 22, 2012, units were dispatched to the area of 57 Mechanic Street for a well being check on an intoxicated male. The male party was identified as Bryce Coutinho. Bryce was located in the area wearing shorts, sweatshirt, and no shoes. While speaking with Bryce I could smell a strong odor of alcohol coming from his breath. Bryce was very unsteady on his feet and swaying from side to side. Bryce was asked if he had any place he could stay and he stated no. Bryce was staying at the shelter on Mechanic Street but was no longer allowed in due to his extreme intoxication. I advised Bryce due to his extreme intoxication he was going to be placed into protective custody for his safety and the safety of others. Bryce was then transported back to the station where he was booked and placed into cell 2. Bryce refused to make a phone call.
