On October 03, 2012 at approximately 21:40 hrs I responded to a pedestrian accident in the area of 479 Hosmer Street. Upon arrival I observed a male party with a black leather jacket and dark clothes on the ground in front of Massachusetts registration [REDACTED]. The male party was bleeding from the head, but was conscious and able to tell me his name. He was identified as Bryce Coutinho (DOB 06-23-1990). When I asked Bryce where he was coming from he stated he had an argument with his girlfriend and just wanted to kill himself. Bryce's speech was slurred and there was a moderate odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his person. The fire department and EMS arrived and took control of the scene. Bryce was transported to Marlborough Hospital by Patriot ambulance.

The scene was secured and witnesses were asked to stay so I could speak with them. I spoke to the operator of the vehicle [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]-1958). [REDACTED] stated the male jumped out in front of his vehicle and he slammed on his brakes, skidding on the wet pavement striking Bryce in the lower body.

I then spoke to [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]-1992) and [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]-1992). [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stated that they were traveling north on Hosmer Street and the male (Bryce) jumped out in front of their vehicle. [REDACTED] swerved and missed him. She then turned her vehicle around and she observed Ma. registration [REDACTED] stopped in the road and Bryce on the ground (affidavits attached).

I spoke to the resident of [REDACTED] Hosmer Street [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]-1972). [REDACTED] stated that he heard a skid and observed Ma. registration [REDACTED] stopped in the road in front of his house and Bryce on the ground.

State Police Accident reconstruction was called and Trooper Michael Mayer arrived within 20 minutes from the Leominster barracks. Once the scene was cleared it was towed by Lands Towing.

On Wednesday 10/3/12, I was working as watch commander on the 4-12 patrol night shift. At about 9:45pm, I responded with other units to Hosmer St. for a report of a pedestrian accident. Upon my arrival, Ofc.King, M.F.D. and Patriot ambulance were all already on scene.

A dark colored Chevrolet Camaro (MA registration # [REDACTED]) was stopped north-bound on the road and Bryce Coutinho was laying on the road in front of the Camaro. The road was wet from rain which had been falling sporadically all evening.

Bryce was conscious, alert and speaking with ambulance personnel in the ambulance. Bryce admitted to intentionally jumping in front of two vehicles in a suicide attempt. The first vehicle was able to avoid Bryce. The occupants of the first vehicle spoke with Ofc.King and confirmed that Bryce did intentionally attempt to jump in front of their vehicle.

The second vehicle could not stop in time, and could not avoid Bryce. The second vehicle did strike Bryce causing him to fall to the road and hit his head. There was some blood on the road, apparently from Bryce's head. The operator of the second vehicle also spoke with Ofc.King and also confirmed that Bryce did intentionally jump in front of his vehicle causing him to hit Bryce.

MA State Police accident reconstruction team also responded to the scene per my request, to assist. The second vehicle was towed to Land's for further inspection by the M.S.P.. Bryce was transported to Marlboro Hospital for treatment and was also issued a section 12 for his admitted intentional suicide attempt. A vehicle crash report will also be completed by Ofc.King.

It appeared that there was NO improper operation by the vehicle that struck Bryce. When Bryce intentionally attempted suicide and jumped in front of the vehicle, the vehicle did appear to stop and slid on the wet pavement. The operator, [REDACTED], waited, spoke with Police and was very cooperative. Bryce is unknown to [REDACTED]. Bryce appeared to have only minor physical injuries, possible minor trauma to the legs from hitting the vehicle and a cut to the head from hitting the roadway.

On 10/03/12 I responded to [REDACTED] Hosmer St to assist at the pedestrian accident. Upon my arrival, I was requested to take measurements of the roadway and accident. The letters correspond to Off King's accident diagram:

A: Width of roadway: 30.2'
B: The east side curb to the center of the double yellow line: 13.8'
C: West side utility pole #55 to driver's side rear corner: 38.0'
D: Center line to driver's side rear corner: 2.8'
E: Center line to driver's side front corner: 3.4'
F: East curb to passenger side front corner: 4.7'
G: East curb to passenger side rear corner: 5.8'
H: Front/center of vehicle to "speedy dry": 6.4'
I: Center line to "speedy dry": 9.8'
J: East curb to "speedy dry": 3.8'
Length of vehicle: 15.1'

After clearing the accident scene, I went to Marlborough Hospital with JDP clinician Abigail Peterson as the suicidal male had been evaluated by her in the past. Upon my arrival there, I was told that the male, Bryce Coutinho, had been placed under a §12 by ER Dr Kennedy. The nurse handling him stated that he was intoxicated which was confirmed by Ms Peterson.

I spoke with the Patriot Ambulance crew that transported Coutinho, Robert Cumming and Michael Bernard, and requested that they document in an affidavit that he admitted to jumping in front of two vehicles, the second striking him. Robert checked with a supervisor and confirmed that due to HIPPA, he was not allowed to write such a report but stated that everything we would need, such as statements, was already in their "run report" and could be obtained via subpoena if required.
