Synopsis

Everett Police responded to call for unknown male harassing pedestrians at Broadway and Chelsea St. Officer arrived on scene, spoke with suspect who subsequently pulled knife from his waist area. Officer retreated ordering suspect to drop knife, suspect advanced on officer. Officer fired several shots in self defense, striking suspect. Suspect transported to MGH and later pronounced deceased. Suspects identity unknown at time of aciss entry

SUBJECT: CASE INITIATION REPORT/ APRIL 21, 2016 EVERETT POLICE FATAL
SHOOTING OF MARIO MEJIA MARTINEZ

1. On Thursday April 21, 2016 at approximately 1700 hours this officer along with Trooper James Connolly being led by Sergeant Peter Sennott responded to a call from Everett Police Detective Sergeant Scott Stallbaum regarding the Everett Police shooting of Mario Mejia Martinez (DOB 1/19/1968) on the corner of Broadway and Norwood Street in Everett.

2. Upon arrival to the scene I met with Sergeant Sennott, Sergeant Stallbaum, Detective Joseph Furtado and Detective Michael Lavey Preliminary investigation revealed that a suspect (who was later identified as Maiio Mejia Martinez) lunged at an on duty uniformed Everett Police Officer with a knife. The officer fired at the suspect hitting him several times

3. Just after my arrival I met with Massachusetts State Police Sergeant Timothy MacDougal (CSSS) and Trooper Robert Quigley (CSSS) who responded to assist with the crime scene Massachusetts State Police Lieutenant David Cahill leading Troopers Michael Bonasoro and David Hughes (FIS- Ballistics Section) also responded to assist. I spoke to Sergeant Macdougal at the scene and he pointed out to me a knife with a silver blade lying in the middle of the street, near where Mejia Martinez was transported from. The knife appeared to have blood on it.

4. Once on scene, Sergeant Sennott directed a plan of investigation which included witness interviews, the securing of video surveillance and audio recording along with crime scene

analysis Troopers and Detectives assigned to the investigations participated in their assigned tasks as directed

5. While on scene I learned that the suspect Mejia Martinez had been transported to the MGH Hospital where he was pronounced deceased.

6 The crime scene was photographed and processed by members of the Crime Scene Services Section, Crime Lab and FIS/ Ballistics Unit. Members of FIS/ Ballistics secured the officer's police issued duty weapon along with the magazine and ammunition carried within the weapon Lieutenant Cahill advised me the duty weapon was a Glock Model 21, .45 caliber semi-automatic pistol I also learned that members of the FIS/ Ballistics secured six spent shell casing from the scene in the intersection of Broadway, Norwood and Chelsea Streets. The six spent shell casings recovered were consistent with all fired spent shell casings being accounted for with respect to the number of live rounds recovered in the weapon (eight total; seven in the magazine and one in the chamber) and the capacity of the Glock 21, which is thirteen rounds in the magazine plus one round in the chamber. Members of FIS/ Ballistics recovered one spent projectile from Mejia Martinez's clothing and three spent projectiles recovered from the autopsy of Mejia Martinez There were two spent projectiles unaccounted for

7. At the time of the writing of this Case Initiation Report, the investigation remains on-going and there will be more investigative reports to follow.
