SUBJECT: Interview of Talal Chaghouri

- 1. On March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019, at approximately 1200 hours, ADA Adrienne Lynch and I spoke with Talal "Joe" Chaghouri in regards to the fatal police officer involved shooting of Alan Greenough at 1426 Main St, Reading. The meeting took place in the executive conference room at the Middlesex District Attorney's Office. During the interview, Chaghouri provided the following new information:
- a) Chaghouri said that, after Greenough's brother, Anthony Perrotti, had entered Grenough's apartment from the door in the lobby of the East Coast gas station, he told Chaghouri that Greenough was not in the apartment. Chagouri said that he told Anthony, "We should give him [Greenough] a few minutes and then report it to the police." Chaghouri said he and Perrotti knew Alan was not in the apartment for 4 or 5 minutes before they told the police and they entered the apartment. He said he told Perrotti, "Let's not talk about it for a few minutes. If he is going to flee, let him not be on the property." Chaghouri said that he and Perrotti feel guilty about it and wish they had told the police about the unlocked door into the apartment earlier. He said that he did not tell me this during our initial interview on the night of the shooting because he was not directly asked about it.
