1. On Monday, November 13, 2012, at approximately 0034 hours, Lieutenant David Giorgi of the Marlborough Police Department and I interviewed [REDACTED] in a conference room at the Marlborough Police Department. [REDACTED] was at the residence of 52 Meadowbrook Road in Marlborough during the time of the incident. [REDACTED] is the girlfriend of [REDACTED] and provided the following statement:

2. Sometime just before 7:00 pm, [REDACTED] & [REDACTED] were at [REDACTED]'s house. [REDACTED] received a text message on his phone to come home from his mother [REDACTED]. Sometime between 7:00 – 7:15 pm, [REDACTED] & [REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED]'s house at 52 Meadowbrook Road in Marlborough. When [REDACTED] & [REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED]'s house, [REDACTED] was there alone. During this time, [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had a conversation about Bryce Coutinho and [REDACTED] breaking up.

3. At approximately 7:30 pm, the front doorbell rang and Bryce Coutinho came back. [REDACTED] answered the front door. Bryce came in and sat on the recliner in the living room. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] all went into the first floor computer room. [REDACTED] remembered [REDACTED] saying that he thought that Bryce had been drinking because he stumbled while walking through the front doorway when walking into the house.



4. At approximately 7:40 pm, [REDACTED] & [REDACTED] arrived at the house. When they arrived, Bryce Coutinho was still sitting on the reclining chair in the living room by himself. [REDACTED] & Bryce went upstairs to her bedroom to talk. [REDACTED] was sitting halfway up the stairs, [REDACTED] was sitting at the bottom of the stairs, [REDACTED] & [REDACTED] was standing in the living room by the stairs. [REDACTED] heard Bryce crying & yelling. Bryce said that he had no where to go. Bryce said that he loved [REDACTED] but [REDACTED] said that he was ending the relationship. Bryce said that he tried to kill himself in the past. At this time, [REDACTED] had [REDACTED] call [REDACTED] downstairs. [REDACTED] called the police. During the 911 phone call, [REDACTED] told the police that Bryce had cut his arms.

5. When the police arrived, [REDACTED] & [REDACTED] were out front smoking a cigarette. [REDACTED] & [REDACTED] were standing on the bottom of the stairs by the front doorway. The first uniformed police officer came into the house and ran upstairs. He knocked on [REDACTED]'s bedroom door. This officer asked to see Bryce's arms. Bryce responded by saying, "Why do you need to see my arms". The police officer asked Bryce again. Bryce said, "You don't need to see my arms". This officer then called the other officer out front for assistance. The second police officer came in very quickly and ran upstairs. The first police officer asked Bryce to get up. Bryce called the officer a faggot. Bryce started yelling, "What are you going to do about it. Are you going to shoot me? Then shoot me." [REDACTED] said that she then heard two gunshots and a loud thump.
