1. On Monday, November 12, 2012, at approximately 2252 hours, Lieutenant David Giorgi of the Marlborough Police Department and I interviewed [REDACTED] in a conference room at the Marlborough Police Department. [REDACTED] was at her residence of 52 Meadowbrook Road in Marlborough during the time of the incident.

2. [REDACTED] advised us that she and her boyfriend [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]/1969) are co-owners of the above residence. [REDACTED] advised that during the time of the incident the following people were present at her house.

- [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]/1959)
- [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]/1990) - Daughter
- [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]/1991) - Son
- [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]/1994) - Son's girlfriend
- Bryce A. Coutinho (DOB: 06/23/1990) - Daughter's boyfriend / Suspect
- [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]/1994) - Daughter's friend

3. On Monday, November 12, 2012, [REDACTED] returned home from work sometime between 4:15pm – 4:30 pm. During this time, her daughter's boyfriend Bryce Coutinho was also in the house as well. At approximately 5:00 pm, [REDACTED] received a text message on her cell phone from her daughter [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said that she was spending the night over [REDACTED]'s house, that [REDACTED] just broke up with her boyfriend Bryce Coutinho and asked him to leave the house. [REDACTED] responded by texting [REDACTED], "Why is he still here and get home". [REDACTED] replied, "I will be home soon". [REDACTED] then texted her son [REDACTED], advised him of what was going on and told him to come home.

4. At approximately 5:30 pm, Bryce came out of [REDACTED]'s bedroom, walked downstairs and walked out the front door. Bryce did not say where he was going, took his cell phone with him, did not mention that he and [REDACTED] broke up. [REDACTED] saw Bryce walk down the street to the right until he was out of sight. [REDACTED] did not see Bryce meet with anyone.

5. At approximately 5:45 pm, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] arrived at the house.

6. At approximately 6:00 pm, Bryce Coutinho came back. Bryce did not have a key to the house and rang the front doorbell. [REDACTED] answered the door and let Bryce into the house. [REDACTED] observed Bryce stumble through the doorway, saw that his eyes were dilated and could smell a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage(s) emanating from Bryce's body. Bryce walked into the living room and sat on the reclining chair. [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] all went into the first floor computer room.

7. At approximately 6:10 pm, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] arrived at the house. [REDACTED] went into the computer room and [REDACTED] went into the living room. Moments later, [REDACTED] and Bryce went upstairs into [REDACTED]'s bedroom to talk. [REDACTED] said that she could hear Bryce crying, saying that he had no where to go and that he loved [REDACTED]. Bryce also said that he was going to "kill himself". [REDACTED] kept saying, "I'm sorry, it's over".

8. At approximately 6:20 pm, [REDACTED] had [REDACTED] call [REDACTED] downstairs into the living room with everyone else. When [REDACTED] came downstairs, Bryce remained upstairs in [REDACTED]'s bedroom by himself. [REDACTED] then called 911 and asked for the Marlborough Police to escort Bryce out of the house because he would not leave. [REDACTED] & [REDACTED] then went out front to smoke a cigarette and wait for the Marlborough Police to arrive.


9. At approximately 6:30 pm, two marked Marlborough Police Cruisers arrived at the house. One uniformed Marlborough Police Officer went upstairs and the other uniformed Marlborough Police Officer was out front with [REDACTED] & [REDACTED]. When the first police officer got to [REDACTED]'s bedroom door, [REDACTED] heard the officer call Bryce's name, asked Bryce to stand up and for Bryce to show him his hands. The officer asked Bryce what he had in his hands. [REDACTED] heard this officer call the officer that was out front, asked him to come inside of the house and said, "He's got a knife, he's got a knife". [REDACTED] heard the first officer say, "Put down the knife". The second police officer came inside of the house and went upstairs. [REDACTED] recalled hearing that there was a lot of yelling for Bryce to put down the knife. Bryce started yelling, "The only way that I am leaving here is if you shoot me. You fucking faggot shoot me. I am not leaving here. Shoot me." [REDACTED] then heard three gun shots. One of the police officers called for assistance over the police radio.

10. A short time later, a third uniformed police officer arrived and went upstairs. [REDACTED] said that she tried to go upstairs, but the third police officer would not let Lynn into [REDACTED]'s bedroom.

11. [REDACTED] described Bryce Coutinho as a binge drinker. She said that Bryce was prescribed prescription medication for ADD. [REDACTED] said that Bryce had attempted suicide in the past and had cuts/scars on the both of his arms.

12. [REDACTED] advised us that this past October 3rd, Bryce & [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. Bryce was very drunk [REDACTED]. Approximately 15 minutes after Bryce left the house and jumped in front of a passing car.
