NARRATIVE FOR DETECTIVE JOHN A COBURN

On Thursday, June 25th 2020 at 11:35 am, I was assigned as Detective for the Town of Pepperell, unmarked unit #98. I heard a call put over the air for shots fired by Sgt. Parker. I began to head towards the downtown area as I was originally unaware of Sgt. Parker's location. Dispatched updated the call came from 13 Tarbell St. It should be noted, that it was later learned that Sgt. Parker and Officer Zink had responded to the address to serve a warrant of apprehension. The paperwork had been faxed to the station by the Probation Department to be served by our agency.

I responded to 13 Tarbell St and arrived just after the ambulance. I was greeted outside the residence by Sgt. Parker. Sgt. Parker stated that Officer Zink was still inside the residence with the male party who was shot. The male party was identified as Christopher Shuttle and I had learned he suffered a single gunshot wound. Sgt. Parker briefly advised that upon entering the home Shuttle had confronted him with a large kitchen knife. Sgt. Parker advised Shuttle had charged him with the knife and as a result Officer Zink had shot Shuttle one time.

Officer Zink emerged from the home shortly after. I spoke with Sgt. Parker and Officer Zink who advised they would both be transported to the hospital for an evaluation following the incident. I advised Officer Zink that because his weapon was discharged it would need to be collected as evidence. I subsequently removed Zink's firearm from his holster, with a gloved hand, and immediately made the weapon safe and placed it into an evidence bag.

Officer Zink and Sgt. Parker were both evaluated at Nashoba Valley Medical Center and released shortly thereafter. The crime scene at 13 Tarbell St was secured by Officer Adams and Officer Maskalenko while a search warrant was obtained.

Officer Zink and Sgt. Parker's firearms were both examined by State Police Ballistics Unit at the Pepperell Police Department and collected as evidence. Additionally, both officers' additional magazines were seized and held for ballistics. Upon returning to the station Officer Zink and Sgt. Parker had just arrived back. Sgt. Parker advised me that upon closer inspection of his exterior vest carrier he noticed an abrasion along his left shoulder strap. Sgt. Parker advised that he had believed the kitchen knife that he was struggling with Shuttle over contacted his external carrier in that area. Sgt. Parker also advised this damage to his vest appeared new and he did not remember seeing it there before. I subsequently collected the external vest carrier and held it for State Police Processing.

Christopher Shuttle was subsequently transported to Lowell General Hospital. Upon reaching Lowell General Hospital Shuttle was med flighted to Brigham and Women's Medical Center. Shuttle was subsequently taken into custody at Brigham and Women's Hospital by Sgt. Maskalenko for the following offenses:

M.G.L C265 S13B Assault and Battery on a Police Officer

Officers of the Pepperell Police Department later contacted Bail Commissioner Matt Day and bail was subsequently denied.
