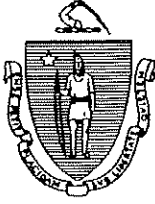

1. On April 21, 2016 at approximately 1800 hours this officer along with Everett Police Detective Joseph Furtado conducted an interview of [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]/1977) at his place of employment at the 8/10 Bar and Grille at 8 Norwood Street in Everett, Massachusetts. The purpose of the interview was to ascertain what information [REDACTED] had relating to the Everett Police shooting of Mario Mejia Martinez (DOB 1/29/1968) in the intersection of Broadway and Norwood Streets in Everett on the afternoon of April 21, 2016.

2. [REDACTED] stated that he works as a bartender for the 8/10 Bar and Grille. He stated that he was working on April 21, 2016 during the time of the incident. He stated that he had gone outside to smoke a cigarette. While outside, he looked at the corner of Norwood Street and Broadway. He observed a uniformed police officer in the middle of Broadway. The police officer was speaking to a Hispanic male in his forties, wearing jeans, boots and a blue shirt. The male speaking to the police officer had a silver knife in his hand which was tucked behind his forearm. The police officer yelled at the male, "Put the knife down" approximately six to seven times. The police officer began to back up away from the man as he continued to yell "Put the knife down"! The male then moved the knife so that the blade was now pointed outward instead of riding along his forearm. The male began walking towards the police officer and was yelling "Fuck you; fuck you"!

3 As the male was yelling at and walking towards the police officer, the officer was backing up. The male reached the curb at the corner of the Cancun restaurant and the police officer stopped in the middle of the street. The police officer yelled again "Put the knife down"! The male then walked towards the police officer and swung the knife, which was in his right hand, at the police officer. The male swung the knife twice at the police officer, with the second appearing to be a swing at the police officers' face. [REDACTED] thought that the male hit the police officer on the second swing. [REDACTED] saw the police officer duck as the knife was swung at him. The police officer then shot approximately five times and the male fell to the ground.

4. [REDACTED] stated that when the male swung the knife at the police officer that he estimated him to be at arm's length.

5. [REDACTED] had no further information and the interview concluded.
