SUBJECT: MAY 2, 2016 INTERVIEW OF [REDACTED]

1. On the morning of May 2, 2016 this officer along with Everett Police Detective Nicholas Crowell conducted an interview of [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]/1991) at the Everett Police station. The purpose of the interview was to ascertain what information if any he had regarding the April 21, 2016 Everett Police involved fatal shooting of Mario Mejia Martinez (DOB 1/29/1968) in Everett Square.

2. [REDACTED] stated that on the afternoon of April 21, 2016 he had been walking down Chelsea Street towards Broadway in Everett. He had been in Everett visiting with his brother. At that time he observed a Hispanic male, 5'10" tall wearing jeans walking around in circles in the area of Norwood Street and Broadway in Everett Square. The Hispanic male looked like he was bothering people, as people were walking away from him as he spoke to them. [REDACTED] then heard sirens in the background. [REDACTED] got onto an MBTA bus and as he did he saw one police cruiser pull up to the corner of Norwood Street and Broadway. The MBTA bus headed north on Broadway

3. The next day [REDACTED] was in Everett Square again and he was approached by a news reporter who had asked him about a police shooting the previous day. He told the reporter that he had watched the April 21, 2016 evening news and saw a news story about a police shooting in Everett Square. [REDACTED] told the reporter that he had heard on the news that the police officer told the man to drop the knife. [REDACTED] stated that the news reporter miss quoted him in the Boston Globe when they

wrote he had heard the police officer say "Drop the knife". [REDACTED] stated that he actually never heard the police officer say anything, as he was on the MBTA bus when the cruiser pulled up.

4. [REDACTED] had nothing further to add and the interview concluded.
